

School Annual Exhibition 2025–26
Theme: Cultural Heritage of India

The Jindal Adarsh Vidyalaya campus radiated with colours, creativity, and cultural pride as students from Pre-Primary to Grade VII presented a magnificent exhibition on 30 & 31 October 2025 with theme **“Cultural Heritage of India.”** The event was a vibrant celebration of India’s glorious traditions and timeless heritage and practices —brought to life through their creative, skilful and artistry exhibits of our young learners.

Smt.Bhuvaneshwari M, Vice-President, Project Procurement – Head, as Chief Guest, and Shri. Mayuresh Bapat, EVP HR-Head as Guest of Honour, inaugurated the exhibition on 30 October 2025. In their inaugural address, the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour applauded the schools’ initiative in nurturing cultural awareness among children, saying, “Such initiatives help young minds connect deeply with their roots and appreciate the beauty of our nation’s heritage.”

Over 1,012 students displayed 333 creative exhibits on various concepts such as Art and Architecture, Traditional Art and Craft, Dance and Music Heritage, Literature and Languages, Science and Knowledge, Food Heritage, Clothing and Textiles. From working models to live demonstrations, every display reflected the students’ innovation, understanding, and teamwork.
