Introduction

- A system of continuous holistic evaluation is followed. There is no formal examination, however the child is evaluated on the basis of regular observations and class assessments. Regular observations are made on monthly and term basis. Focus is on personalized learning experience and holistic development. Skill areas assessed are:
- *Gross motor skills: For eg. Hopscotch, bubble play, playground play etc.
- *Fine motor skills: For eg. Drawing and Colouring, writing, Clay art, planting plant, learning to tie shoe lac etc.
- *Eye-hand coordination: For eg. Reading, writing, puzzles, build with Lego, stringing beads, join the dots etc.
- *Numeracy skills: For eg. Counting, identification and writing of number and number names, sorting, arranging, patterns, addition, subtraction etc.
- *Literacy skills: Fine motor practice, reading writing, identification, uppercase and lowercase letters, sight words, action, position words etc.

- Social skills: For eg. Playing and working in groups, sharing et
- Environmental studies: For eg. Knowledge about nature, people, animals and things around us etc.
- ➤ Physical Development: For eg. Physical training , yoga, aerobics, laughing yoga etc
- Creative skills: For eg. Dance, music, clay art, enacting etc
- Personality development: For eg. Taking care of self, Concept presentation, Fancy dress, Participation in social activities etc.
