The Annual Day 2024-25 was a resounding success, filled with joy, learning, and celebration, marking yet another milestone in the journey of Jindal Vidya Mandir.





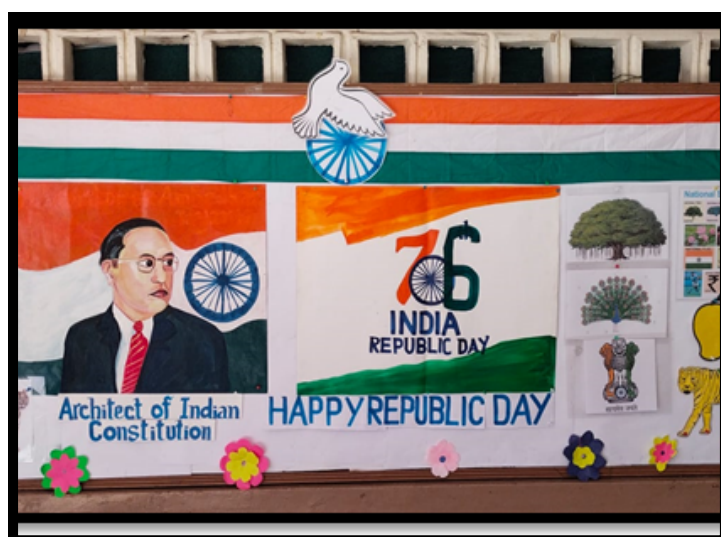
Republic Day Celebration 2024-25

Training Schedule: 26th January (Sunday)

- Session Timing: 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM
- Duration: 10 consecutive Sundays ● Total Hours per Session: 3 hours

Demonstration of the presence of Air in Soil*

To show that air is present in soil: By pouring water into a soil sample, students can observe the air bubbles escaping, indicating the presence of air in the soil.



Demonstrating the Role of Oxygen for Burning.

To show that oxygen is necessary for burning: By using a candle or a small flame in a closed container, students observe how the flame extinguishes when the oxygen is depleted.

This experiment helps students develop essential scientific skills, such as observation, inference, and critical thinking, while understanding a fundamental concept in science.



Making of 3-D model of an aquarium

Students learn to identify and create the various parts of an aquarium, such as plants, fish, gravel, and decorations.

Students have the opportunity to design and create their own unique aquarium model, promoting creativity and imagination.

Students learn about the interconnectedness of living organisms and their environment in an aquarium ecosystem.

Through the process of crafting and assembling the model, students refine their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination

Students of class 4B and 4C participated in class activity of Olympic Symbols. It helped them to learn about the different colours of rings and the significance of each colour.



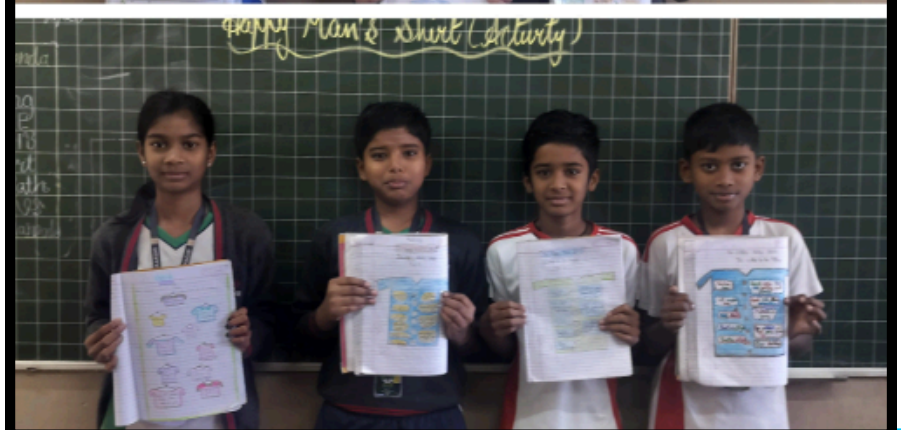

Successful Completion of Phase 3 Medical Health Checkup Jan-2025

The Phase 3 Medical Health Checkup was successfully conducted at the VVN Campus Vidyanagar School Campus 2 under the guidance of Principal Mrs. Ishwari k Sharma and the leadership of Ms. Shantala, the School Nurse. The event was a grand success with the full support from VP Sir, HM of VVN, and Ms. Sabitha Srinivasan, who played a crucial role in teaming up with Ms. Shantala throughout the program.



The health checkup for 8 days took place on January 10th, 11th, 17th, 18th, and from 21st to 24th, 2025, in collaboration with Sanjeevani Hospital. A total of 677 students received the medical evaluations:
