Global Handwashing Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm by our Kindergarten learners, highlighting the importance of good hygiene and healthy habits.

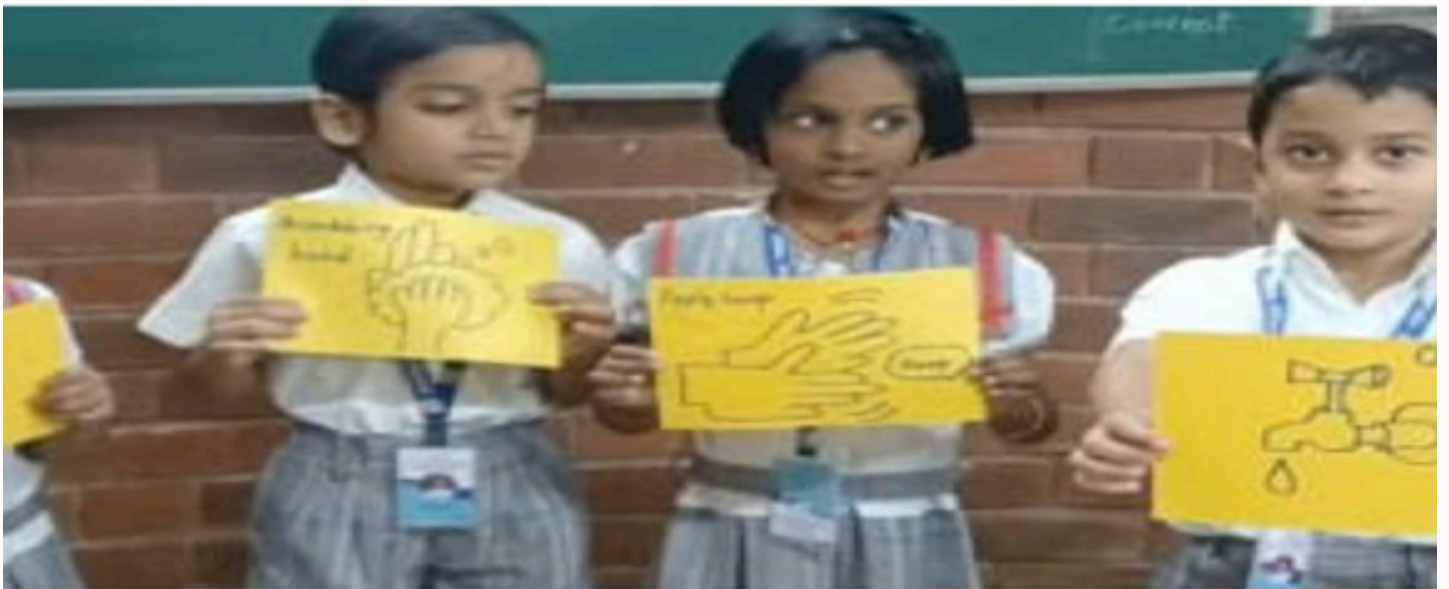

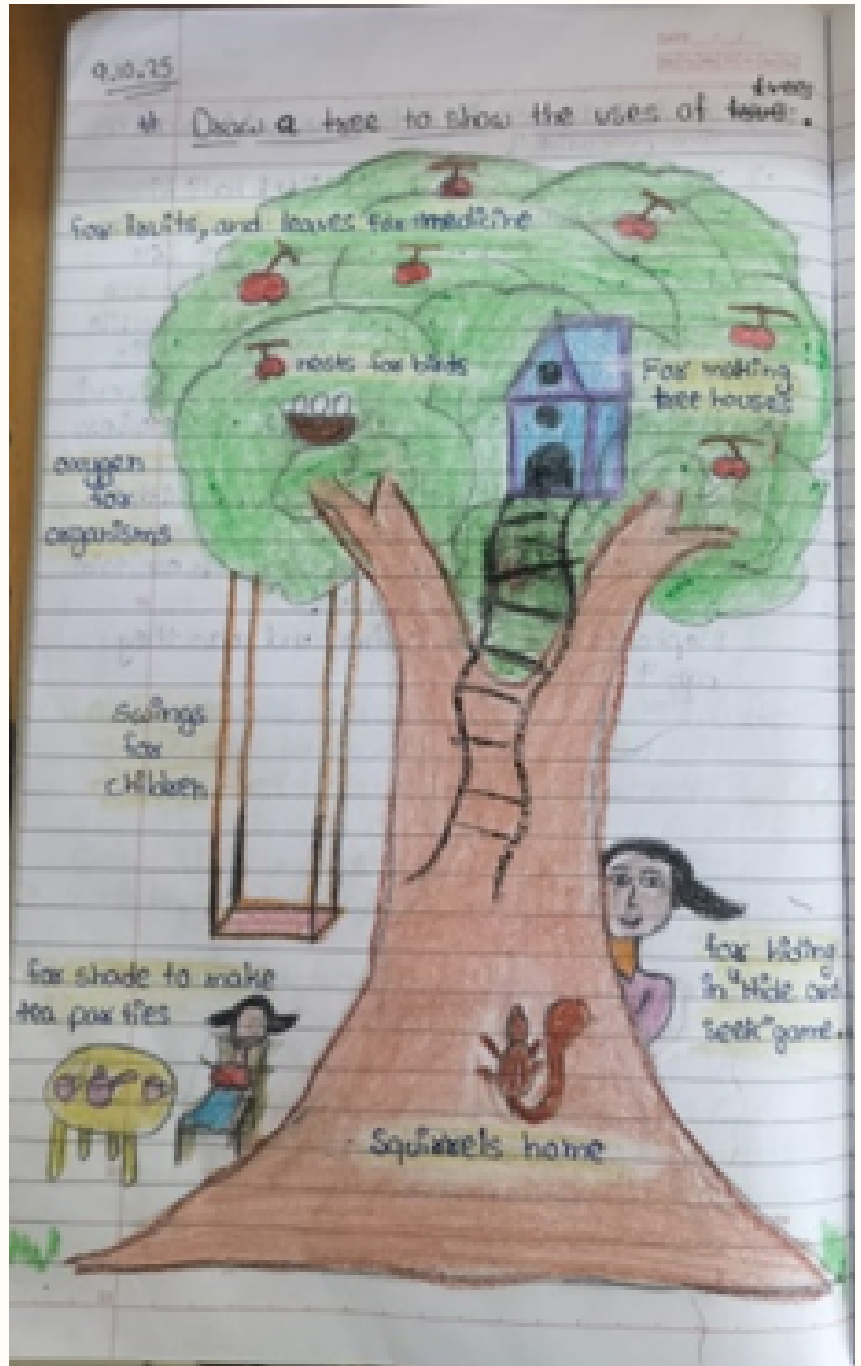
“ART INTEGRATION – MIND MAP ON ‘USES OF TREES’”

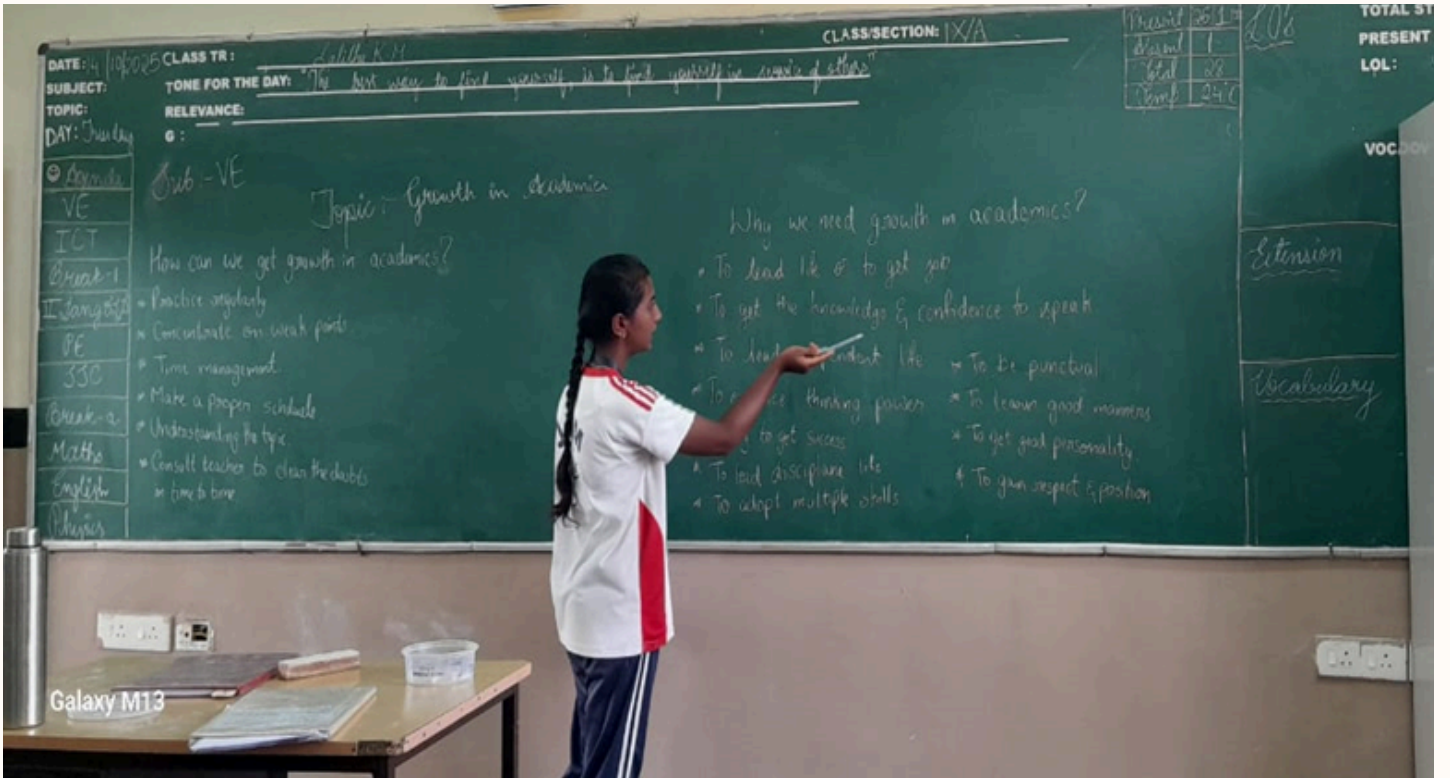

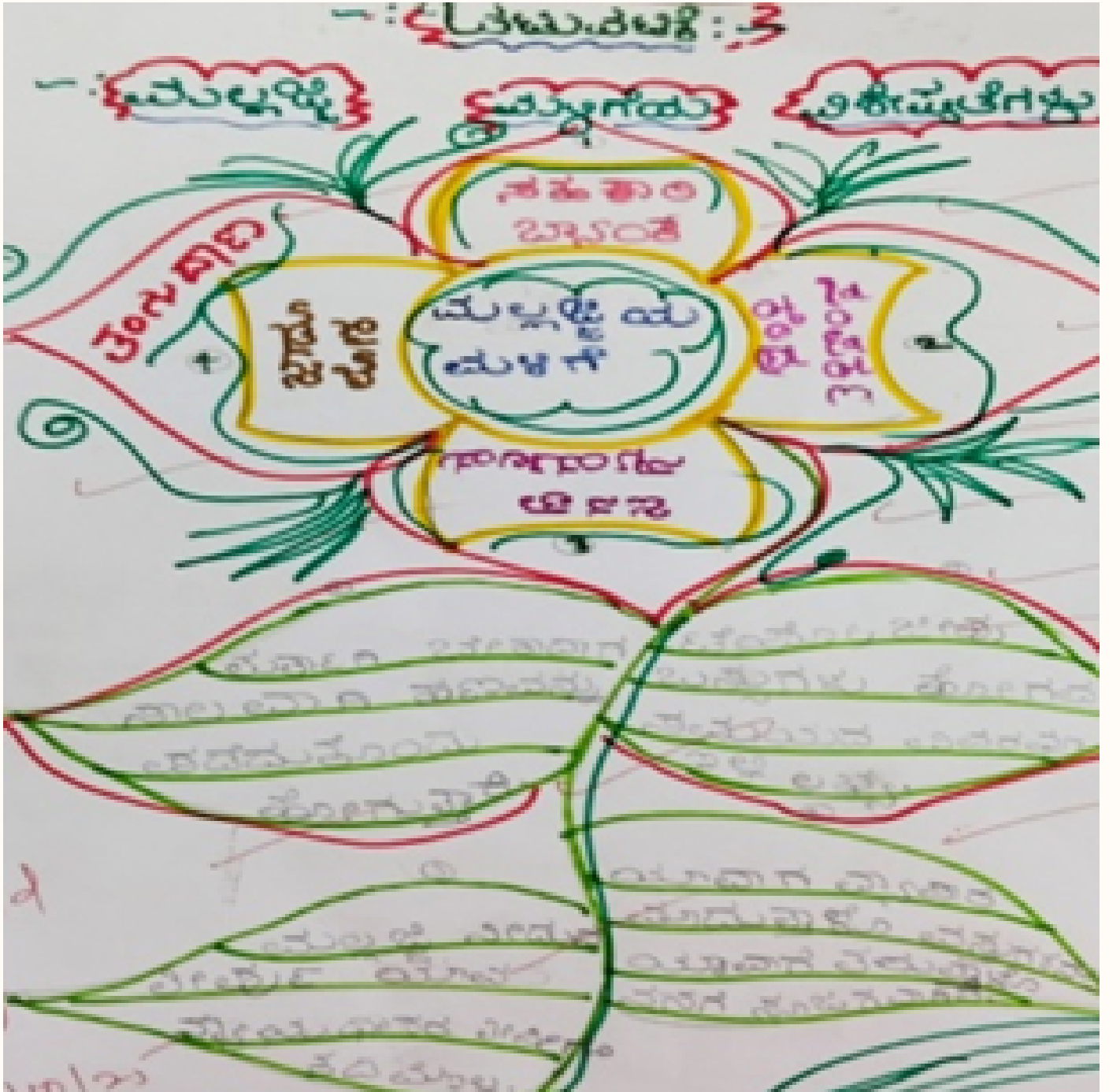

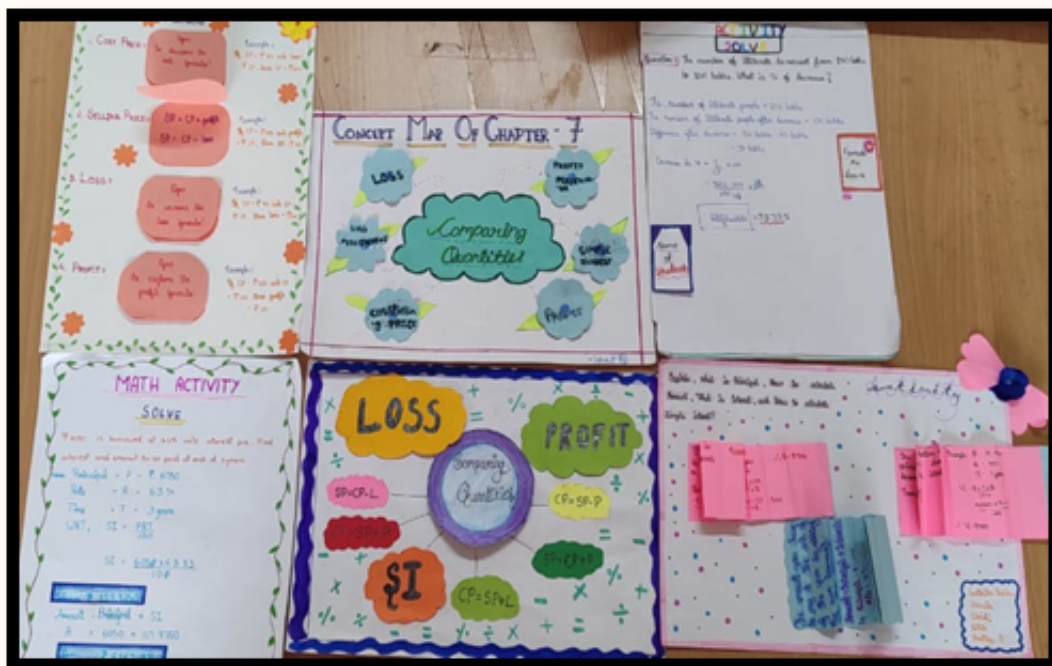


DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS

Where logic meets curiosity!

The month of October was highly productive for the Mathematics Department of JVM Vidyanagar. Students demonstrated remarkable enthusiasm and improvement in logical reasoning, actively participating in both academic and co-curricular mathematics activities.

The department continues to inspire learners to view mathematics not just as a subject—but as a way to think, reason, and innovate!



ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Along with regular classes, doubt-clearing sessions for Term-II syllabus were initiated daily for Classes IX to XII.

Remedial sessions were organized to support students needing additional help in algebra and geometry concepts.

Weekly mental math and problem-solving exercises were integrated into classroom teaching to enhance logical reasoning, accuracy, and speed.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school organized the Aryabhata Ganit Challenge 2025, a mathematics-based competition aimed at promoting analytical thinking, logical reasoning, and a love for numbers.

Over 100 students from Classes VIII to X participated in Level I of the challenge with great enthusiasm.

The top three performers have been shortlisted for the second level of the competition at the international stage.

Mathematics quiz sessions were conducted for Classes VI–VIII to encourage students to explore the fun side of mathematics beyond the classroom.

EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING SESSION – OCTOBER 2025

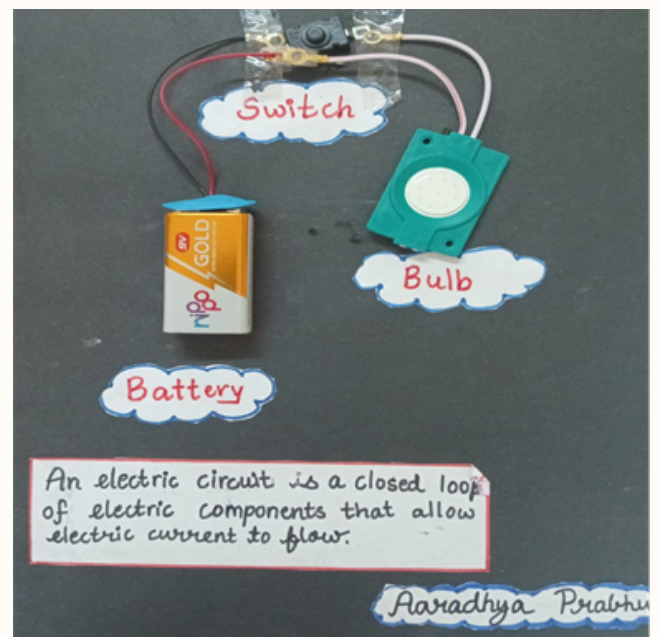
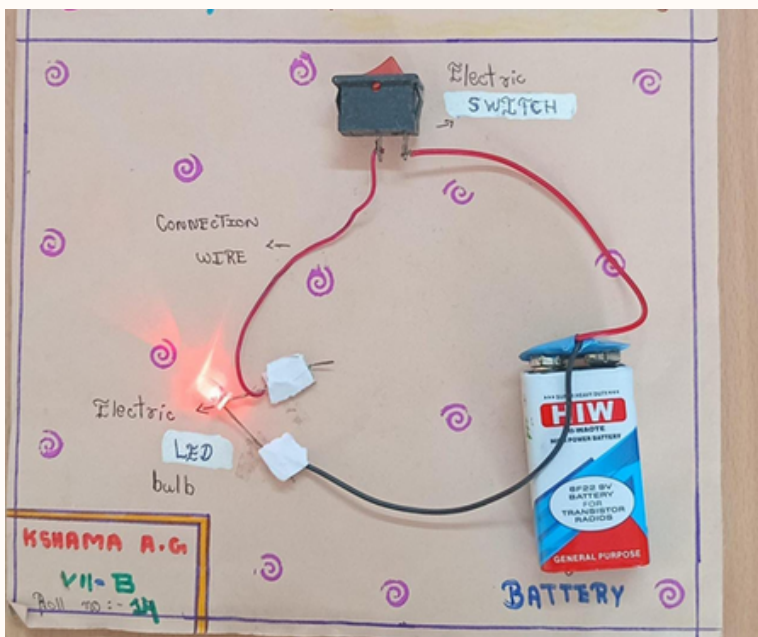
Learning by doing sparks curiosity and understanding!

Topic: Simple Electric Circuit

Class: 7

Students explored the fascinating world of electric circuits through a hands-on activity — making a simple circuit using a cell, bulb, switch, and wires.

Through this engaging session, they observed how electric current flows and how the bulb glows when the circuit is complete. They also discovered what happens when the switch is opened or closed, reinforcing the concept of open and closed circuits in a practical way.

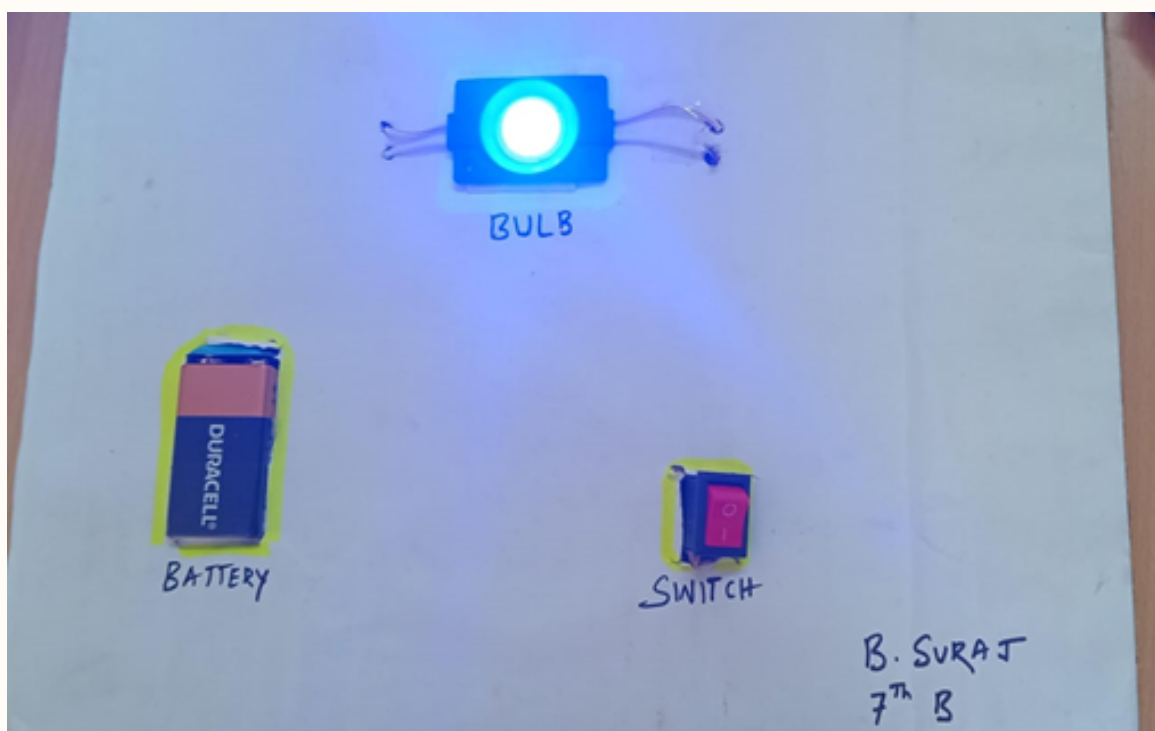


Practical (Hands-on) Skills Developed

This experiential approach made learning interactive, meaningful, and memorable, helping students connect textbook theory with real-life applications.

Topic: Acids, Bases, and Salts

Students conducted an exciting hands-on activity to explore the properties of acids and bases using turmeric paper — a natural indicator. They tested everyday substances such as soap, lemon juice, vinegar, and baking soda, and observed the colour changes when acids and bases interacted.

Through careful observation, students learned to identify acids and bases based on visible reactions and colour variations on turmeric paper.



Practical Learning Outcomes

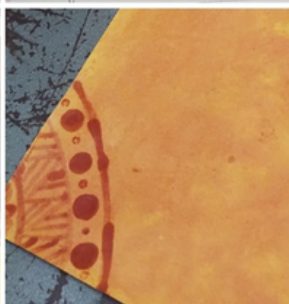
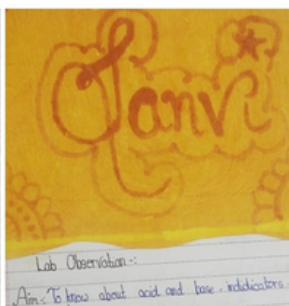

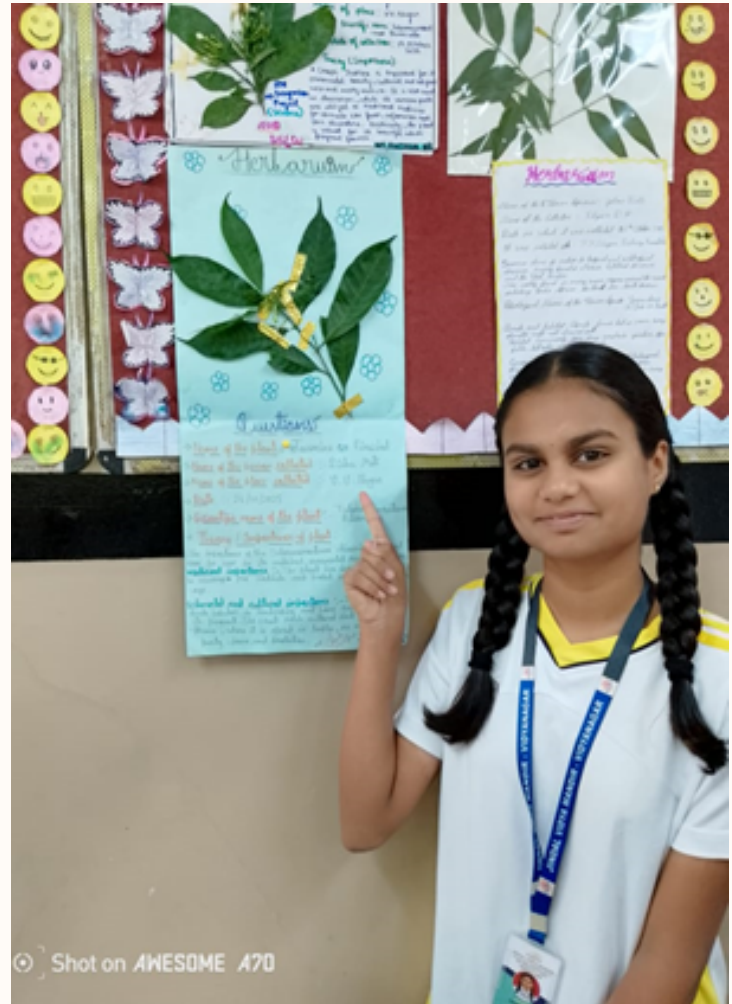
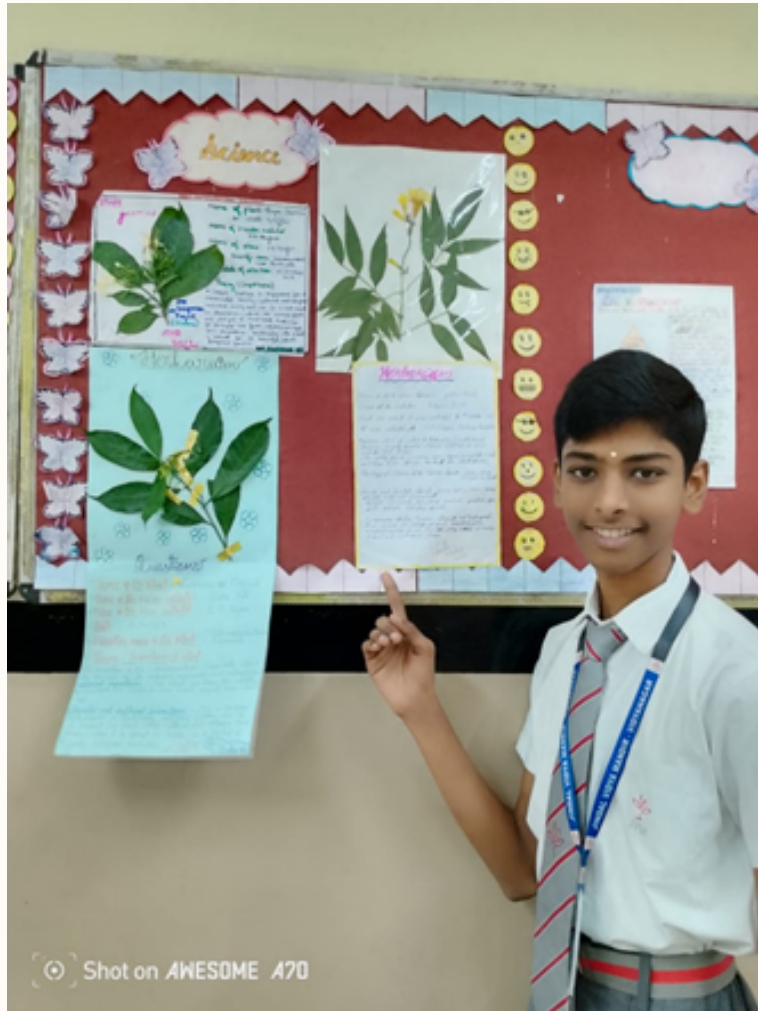




3 D Models of Insects crafted by creative hands of Grade 3 Students

EXAMINATION DEPARTMENT

“Examinations are not just tests of memory, but milestones of learning.”

The month of October 2025 was a significant and productive period for the Exam Department, marked by the successful completion of two major assessments — the Term I Retest Examinations and the Weekly Test conducted before the Diwali vacation.

1. Term I Retest Examinations (8th – 16th October 2025)

The Term I Retest Examinations were organized for students who could not appear for the main exams due to medical reasons or unforeseen emergencies. This considerate initiative ensured that every learner received a fair opportunity to complete their academic evaluation for the term.

The retests were conducted smoothly across all grades from 8th to 16th October 2025, reflecting the department’s dedication to academic fairness, inclusivity, and equal opportunity.

2. Weekly Test (17th October 2025)

Following the completion of the retests, a Weekly Test was conducted on 17th October 2025, just before the Diwali break. This assessment covered one chapter from each subject, carrying a total of 20 marks, and focused on the syllabus completed after the Term I exams.

The objective was to ensure learning continuity and reinforce recently taught concepts. Acting as a bridge between Term I and the upcoming academic sessions, the test helped teachers evaluate students' grasp of new lessons while promoting consistent study habits.

Through these timely evaluations, the Exam Department continues to strengthen the school's examination system — upholding values of fairness, consistency, and continuous learning at Jindal Vidya Mandir, Vidyanagar.

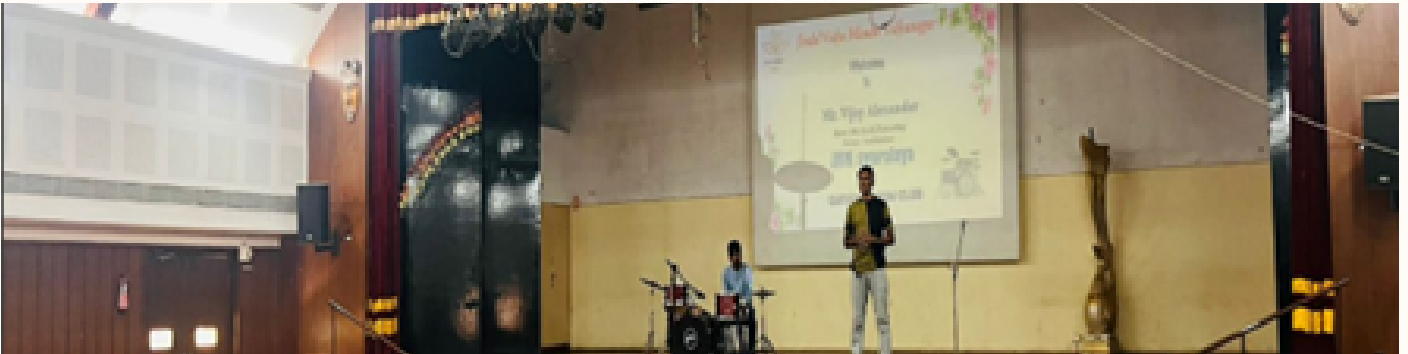

POCSO SEMINAR & TRAINING

The seminar aimed to educate students and staff about the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and to promote a safe, respectful, and secure learning environment.

The session was led by Ms. Natasha Singh, an expert in POSH and POCSO and a Principal Consultant in the field. The seminar was divided into two sessions, each tailored to meet the needs of different participant groups — students and staff members.



Session 1: POCSO Awareness for Students

- **Reporting Mechanisms for Online Crimes**
- **Consequences of Pranks and Misuse of Social Media**
- **Appropriate Use of Language and Body Language**

The interactive session empowered students with awareness and self-protection strategies, helping them make responsible digital choices while understanding the importance of online and offline safety.



Session 2: POCSO Training for Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff

Mr. Prasad eloquently explained how satellites play a crucial role in modern life — from communication, weather forecasting, and navigation to disaster management and agricultural monitoring.

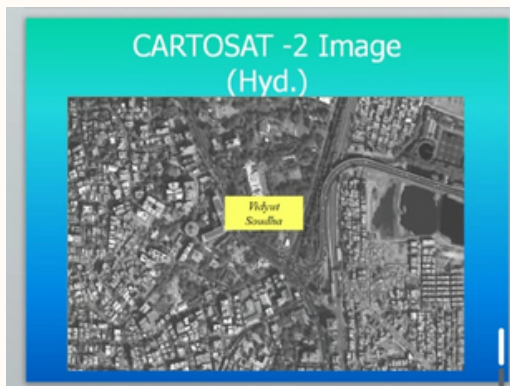
