हिंदी विभाग की गतिविधियाँ


उद्देश्य: “भाषा कौशल के साथ-साथ संस्कार, संस्कृति एवं जीवन मूल्यों का विकास करना था।”







Akshara, trained at Jindal Squash Academy and sponsored by JSW Steel, became Champion in the Girls U-11 category at the Scottish Junior Open (28–30 Dec 2025) and secured 6th position at the British Junior Open (2–6 Jan 2026). Aryan emerged as Champion (1st Place) at the Scottish Squash Open, Edinburgh, and achieved 18th position at the British Junior Open, gaining valuable exposure at an elite global tournament.

INNOVATORS HACKATHON 2026

Aryan Tripathi of Class XI C, Jindal Vidya Mandir, Vidyanagar, proudly represented the school as a solo participant at the prestigious Innovators Hackathon 2026, a national-level event featuring participants from IITs, NITs, VIT, COEP, Symbiosis, NMIET, Amity Dubai, and other renowned institutions. On Day 1, the event began with registration, inauguration, and mentor sessions by Dr. Vinod Kumar and Mr. Chaitanya Shraavan from T-Hub, followed by lab-based project preparation. On Day 2, Aryan presented his project titled “Suraksha Drone AI”, an AI-based drone surveillance solution designed for real-time public safety monitoring. The project received positive feedback, with expert guidance offered on cost feasibility, technical scope, and future incubation support.





The experience greatly enhanced confidence, analytical thinking, and exposure to national innovation standards. It served as an inspiring milestone in the student’s learning journey, encouraging young minds to pursue innovation with curiosity, determination, and a forward-thinking approach.

EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO DAROJI AGRICULTURE FARM

Grade 9 students visited Daroji Agricultural Farm on 24 January 2026 as part of their educational learning linked to the Science chapter Improvement in Crop Production. 
HEALTH & SAFETY DEPARTMENT

“Healthy children learn better, grow stronger, and shine brighter.”

As part of its continued commitment to student wellbeing, the Health & Safety Department successfully conducted Phase 3 of the School Health Check-up Programme in January 2026. Under the guidance of the Principal, Ms. Ishwari K. Sharma, the programme was efficiently coordinated by Ms. Shantala, School Nurse, in collaboration with Sanjeevani Hospital. This phase covered students of Grades 1 and 4, and on 31 January 2026, a total of 146 students were screened. The health assessment was carried out by a team of specialists including a Pediatrician for general health and growth, an ENT Specialist for ear, nose, and throat evaluation, and an Ophthalmologist for vision screening.

Conducted as part of the CBSE-mandated Annual Health Assessment and the school’s phased health monitoring initiative, the programme aimed to track physical health, detect concerns at an early stage, and promote preventive healthcare. The check-up was completed smoothly with the cooperation of students and staff, and parents were informed wherever follow-up was required. The department remains dedicated to ensuring the health and safety of every child through structured and continuous health initiatives.






EXPERT DEMO GUIDANCE PROGRAM


COLLABORATIVE LEARNING FOR MEANINGFUL TEACHING – PLC HIGHLIGHTS OF JANUARY
