- रिवीजन वर्कशीट्स : प्रत्येक पाठ/कविता के लिए महत्वपूर्ण प्रश्नों, अति लघु उत्तर, लघु उत्तर और दीर्घ उत्तर वाले प्रश्नों की वर्कशीट तैयार करें। छात्रों को हल करने को दें।
- ग्रुप डिस्कशन : महत्वपूर्ण टॉपिक्स (जैसे पाठों के केंद्रीय भाव, कवियों/लेखकों के बारे में, सामाजिक मुद्दे) पर समूह चर्चा आयोजित करें।
- सैंपल पेपर सॉल्विंग : सीबीएसई द्वारा जारी सैंपल पेपर और पिछले वर्षों के प्रश्नपत्र हल करें।
- विस्तृत उत्तर लेखन अभ्यास : दीर्घ उत्तरीय प्रश्नों के उत्तर लिखने का अभ्यास कराएं। शब्द सीमा और समय का ध्यान रखें।
- पाठ सारांश और नोट्स बनाना : छात्रों को प्रत्येक पाठ/कविता का संक्षिप्त सारांश और महत्वपूर्ण बिंदुओं के नोट्स बनाने को कहें।
- कविता और गद्यांश पाठन - निर्धारित कविताओं और गद्यांशों का वाचन और विश्लेषण करें।
- व्याकरण रिवीजन और अभ्यास - व्याकरण के महत्वपूर्ण टॉपिक्स (वाक्य, काल, वाच्य, संधि, समास, अलंकार, मुहावरे-लोकोक्तियाँ) का रिवीजन कराएं और अभ्यास कराएं।
- डाउट सेशन : नियमित डाउट सेशन आयोजित करें जहां छात्र अपने संदेह पूछ सकें।
- मोटिवेशनल सेशन : छात्रों का मनोबल बढ़ाने और उन्हें परीक्षा के लिए प्रेरित करने के लिए समय-समय पर मोटिवेशनल सेशन आयोजित करें।

DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE

“Science is a journey of discovery, curiosity, and innovation.”

Students across various classes actively participated in engaging science experiments and hands-on activities that transformed classroom learning into meaningful exploration. These practical experiences helped students understand scientific concepts in an interactive manner, fostering critical thinking, observation skills, and problem-solving abilities. Through enthusiastic participation, our young learners explored the wonders of science with curiosity and dedication.

Grade 4 students took part in an exciting activity by creating 3D models of different human body organ systems. This hands-on learning experience enabled them to understand the functioning of the human body in a creative and engaging way. Using clay, cardboard, charts, recycled materials, and colors, students designed models of systems such as the digestive, respiratory, and excretory systems. The activity enhanced their conceptual clarity while encouraging creativity and teamwork.





Grade 6 students brought the wonders of space to life through an engaging role play activity on the Solar System. Each student confidently represented a planet, presenting key facts about its characteristics, position, and movement around the Sun.

This creative and interactive activity helped students develop a clearer understanding of the structure and functioning of the Solar System in an enjoyable manner. It also enhanced their communication skills, teamwork, and confidence while making learning both meaningful and memorable.



In Grade 5, students explored the concepts of weather and climate through an engaging activity and chart presentation method. Using charts, diagrams, and maps, they explained different weather conditions, the phenomenon of sea breeze and land breeze, and illustrated the climatic zones of the Earth.

The lesson aimed to help students clearly understand the meaning of weather and climate and identify the main elements of weather such as temperature, wind, rainfall, and humidity. The activity enhanced their conceptual understanding while developing presentation skills, observation abilities, and confidence in explaining scientific concepts.



Grade 7 students experienced experiential learning through the observation of a specimen of the human heart. With close observation and guided explanation, they explored the structure of the heart, including its chambers and valves.

This hands-on experience helped students gain a deeper understanding of how the heart functions, strengthening their conceptual clarity and fostering scientific curiosity through practical learning.



Grade 8 students enthusiastically conducted two interesting science experiments to explore the concept of electrical conductivity. In the first experiment, pencil leads were placed in a cup of water and connected to dry cells and an LED. The LED glowed dimly at first and shone brighter when a small amount of salt was added, demonstrating that water conducts electricity when it contains dissolved salts or impurities. In the second experiment, iron nails were dipped in lemon juice and connected to a battery and an LED. The LED glowed clearly, proving that lemon juice conducts electricity.

These practical activities helped students understand that liquids containing acids or dissolved substances produce ions, which enable the flow of electric current. The experiments strengthened conceptual clarity while promoting observation skills and scientific reasoning.



Grade 9 students participated in concept-integrated learning experiences on the topics of Electricity and Sound, effectively combining theoretical knowledge with practical application. Through hands-on activities and guided exploration, students were able to connect classroom concepts with real-life phenomena.

These integrated learning experiences strengthened their conceptual clarity and encouraged scientific thinking, curiosity, and collaborative learning, making the study of physics more engaging and meaningful.






EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS – PRIZE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY

JET PRINCIPALS' MEET 2026

JVM Standardization – Academic & Operations Excellence Handbook

“Standardising Excellence, Strengthening Systems”

9th February to 13th February 2026

The JET Principals' Meet was successfully conducted from 9th February to 13th February 2026, bringing together school leaders for five days of intensive collaboration and structured planning. The primary objective of this meet was to bring all domains of the school system under one umbrella of standardisation, ensuring that every institution follows uniform formats, procedures, and Standard Operating Protocols (SOPs).

Purpose of the Meet

The meeting focused on aligning approximately 50–60 academic and non-academic domains across schools. Each school was assigned specific domains to present the SOPs and formats they currently follow. These presentations were followed by detailed discussions, brainstorming sessions, and constructive deliberations to refine, standardise, and finalise the formats. The final approval of all documents will be taken from JET before implementation.



Day-wise Highlights

Day 1 – Operational Foundations

The sessions began with prayer and setting the tone for the day. Key discussions revolved around administrative and operational domains such as attendance registers (class wise and staff wise), substitution registers, medical record formats, uniform policy, cleaning and housekeeping checklists, and maintenance schedules. The day concluded with a review and consolidation of the formats discussed.

Day 2 – Academic Planning & Framework

The focus shifted to core academic systems including curriculum framework (school-wise and grade-wise), class timetable formats, and the Annual Academic Planner. Important discussions were also held on PTM formats, homework/classwork policy, and assessment mapping aligned with CBSE standards.



Day 3 – Documentation & Student Support Systems

The third day addressed school diary formats, first aid checklists, parent grievance redressal systems, fee receipt formats, bonafide and transfer certificates, employee ID cards, and teacher logbooks. Remedial and enrichment program guidelines, as well as transport rules and bus route details, were also discussed and refined.

Day 4 – Policies, Branding & Safety

Day four focused on discipline reporting formats, school handbook for parents, standardized certificate designs, event branding (banners, posters, signage), admission forms and SOPs, CCTV coverage norms, internal transfer policy, fire safety SOP, and school stationery standardisation.

Day 5 – Governance, Assessment & Digital Integration

The final day concentrated on visitor registers, gate pass systems, lab safety guidelines, school rules and code of conduct, SOPs for events, exam policy and formats, assessment rubrics, report card design, ERP module standardisation, digital attendance systems, fee management modules, and online admission portal standardisation.



Engaging Beginnings

Each day commenced with a prayer and a positive tone-setting session. Adding energy and enthusiasm, the last two days began with special icebreaker activities organised by the Sports Department.

- A lively relay race activity energised the participants.
- On the fifth day, the morning began with Yoga, Laughter Yoga, and Standing Yoga, creating a refreshing and joyful atmosphere before the formal sessions began.


Outcome of the Meet
