**ANNUAL CONCLUDING PTA MEETING
A COLLABORATIVE STEP TOWARDS EXCELLENCE**

The Annual Concluding PTA Meeting of Jindal Vidya Mandir, Vidyanagar, was held on 10 March 2026 with enthusiastic participation from parents, teachers, and the school leadership. The meeting served as a meaningful platform to review the academic year 2025–26 and to strengthen the partnership between parents and the school community.

The session began with a comprehensive review of the academic year, highlighting student achievements, developmental initiatives, and the collective efforts of teachers and parents. Constructive feedback was shared, emphasizing continuous improvement and future readiness of students.

Key academic updates were presented by the school leadership. The Vice Principal released the Academic Calendar, outlining month-wise themes, activities, and important dates. The revised fee structure, with an approximate increase of 7%, was explained as a necessary step to support enhanced facilities and new initiatives. Parents were also encouraged to contribute to the Book Bank Initiative by donating used textbooks to support students in need.

Safety and transport concerns raised by parents were addressed with assurance. Measures such as assigning attendants on each bus and finalizing transport routes in consultation with authorities were proposed to ensure student safety and convenience.

In response to parent requests, the deadline for student continuation was extended to 31 March 2026. The school also shared plans for sports development, with the MQ Team identifying and training students for elite programmes, which was well appreciated by parents.

The meeting also highlighted upcoming prestigious events, including the National Economic Challenge leading to the World Youth Forum Dual Summits 2026 in Hong Kong and Macau, and participation in the LIT Model United Nations Conference in Bangalore.

The Open Forum provided an opportunity for parents to share valuable suggestions and appreciations. Recommendations such as sharing digital and printable academic calendars, enhancing career counselling, and improving communication were positively received. The meeting concluded on a positive note, reinforcing the shared commitment of the school and parents towards nurturing responsible, confident, and future-ready learners.

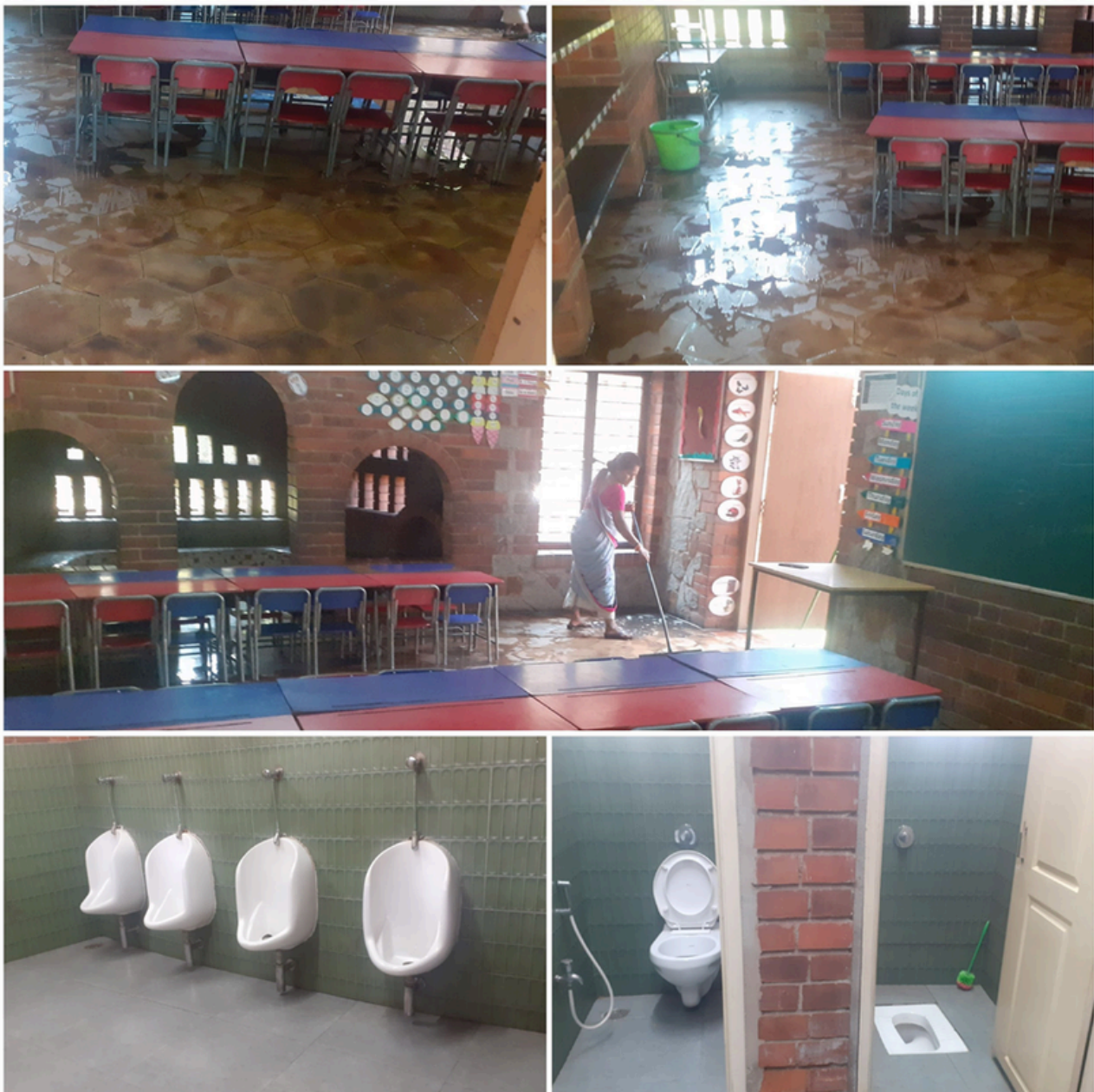
HEALTH AND SAFETY DEPARTMENT

Sharma, with dedicated coordination by Ms. Shantala, School Nurse, enabling smooth and organized execution.
