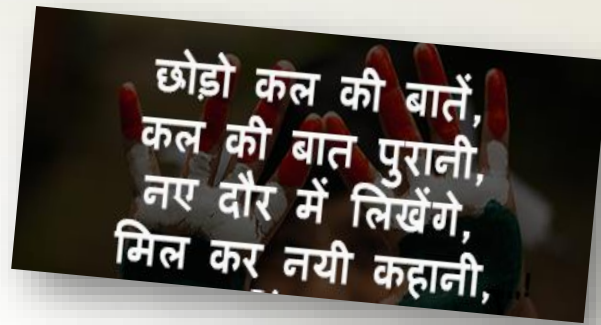
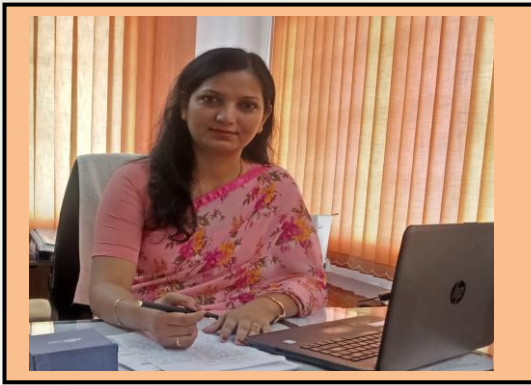

It is indeed pertinent to mention that online education has following benefits-

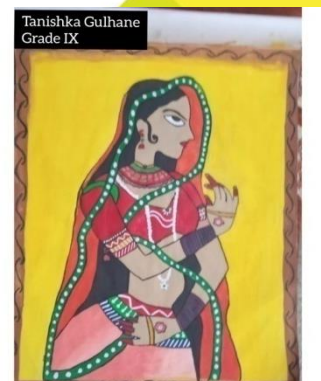
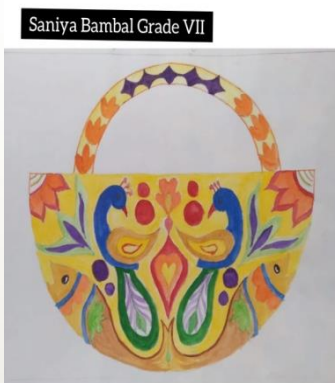
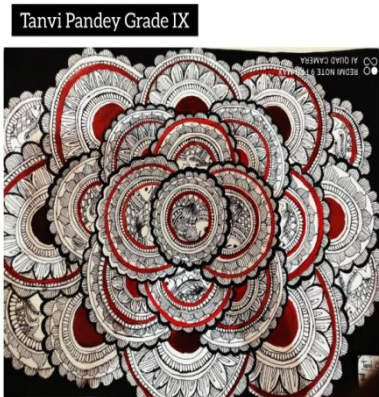
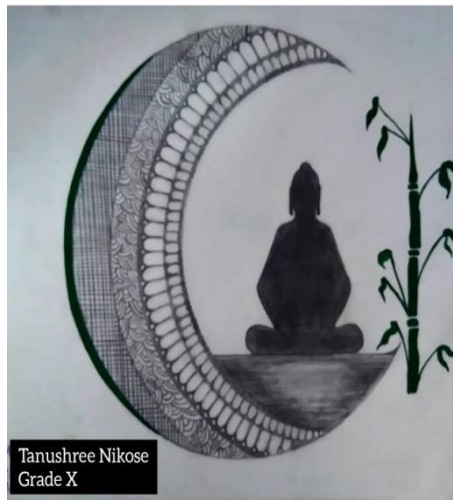
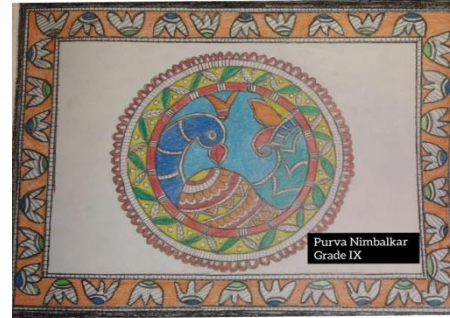
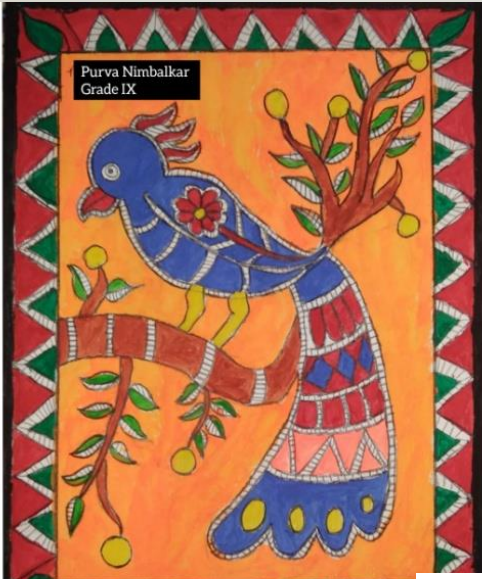
- The education has reached children crossing the four walls of classrooms.

Mrs Geeta Nannaware- Div. Forest Officer, Social Forest Nagpur also appreciated the participants for their efforts and congratulated the winners.

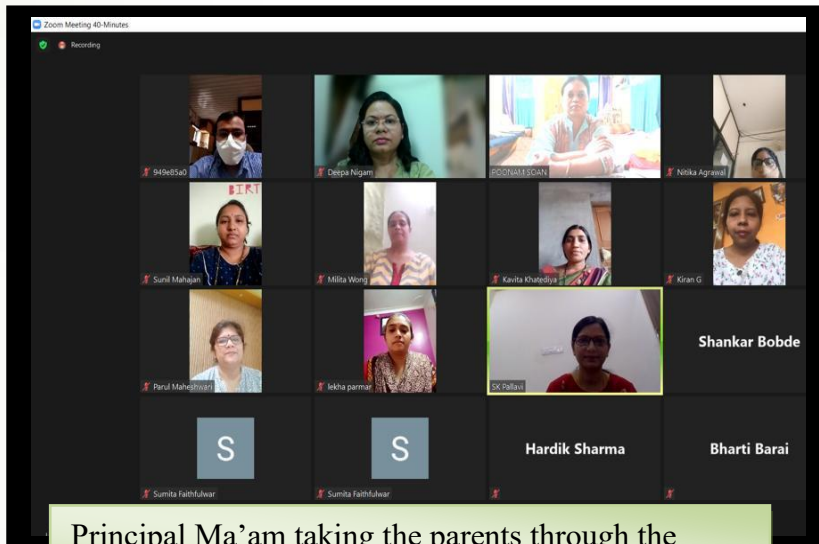

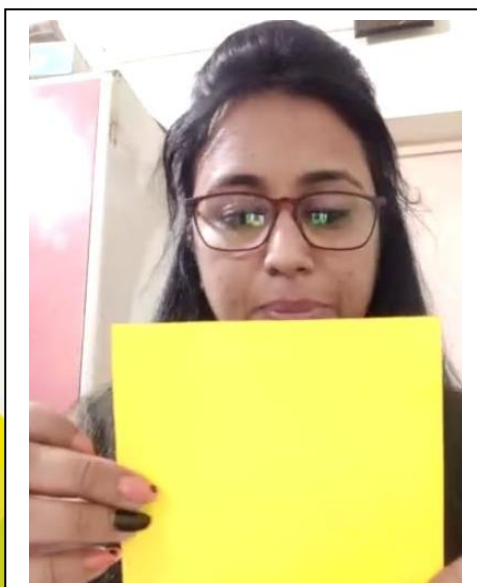
