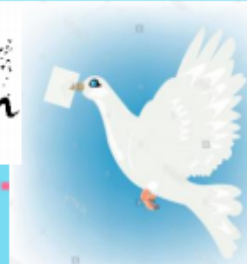

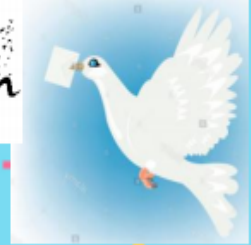




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Health care during this pandemic-

Pre-primary teachers capacity building program by Key Foundation-

"An investment in knowledge pays the best interest."

JSW Foundation created the platform for the teaching fraternity to associate with Key Education Foundation for attending the Self Training Modules for continuous improvement.

The training held from 5th April 2021 to 22nd May 2021 on an online platform. In this STM there were 13 modules along with sub modules and each module was comprising with an assignment for checking the understanding and assimilation of knowledge and skills.

The training covered the study of Early Childhood Education (ECE) and the teaching strategies using the Play way techniques. It also aimed at the holistic development of a child's social, emotional, cognitive and physical needs and build a solid foundation for the development of the child. Ms. Milita Wong, Ms. Alisha Pillay and Ms Pallavi Chakkilala actively participated from JVM Kalmeshwar. The teachers have expressed gratitude towards the management for the opportunities granted for capacity building.





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Professional Development through Firki, an initiative by Teach for India -

"Learning is a continuous process as the life never stop teaching.."

We all learn one or the other things in our day to day life. Similarly JVM also took the initiative to upgrade their teachers professional development area through firki an initiative by teach for India.

Firki is a blended (online and offline) learning model, focuses on the principles and strategies, which have proven successful in improving teacher competencies in low-resource communities. Through courses, webinars, learning groups, one-on-one mentor support and classroom observation and feedback, Firki helps teachers identify their strengths and leverage them to build an effective practice, leading to improved student outcomes.

The training included :

- Integrating for an Excellent Education: this course taught teachers about how our students vision for significant and part changing learning can be turned into action using classroom culture, instructional strategies and content.
- Integrating Art in Education: Art integration is an approach to teaching in which students construct and demonstrate understanding through an art form. They are engaged in a creative process which connects an art form and another subject area to meet the objectives in both.
- Beyond traditional subject area: In this teachers learnt about a few non-traditional subject areas. Two mainframe works in this particular course are SEL (Social Emotional Learning) and SEEL (Social Emotional Ethical Learning) as these two aspects talk about students development which forms a more holistic approach towards education.
- Virtual teaching and learning: in this course teachers learnt about how they can teach to the students online using different tools and applications available and choose the right tool for the particular context like Google forms, Google classroom etc.

All these trainings were attended by our teachers online and in offline mode. Total 18 of our teachers attended these trainings along with the Principal Ms C. Pallavi.

The team has extended special gratitude towards JSW Foundation for the support and encouragement towards continuous Professional Development of the staff.

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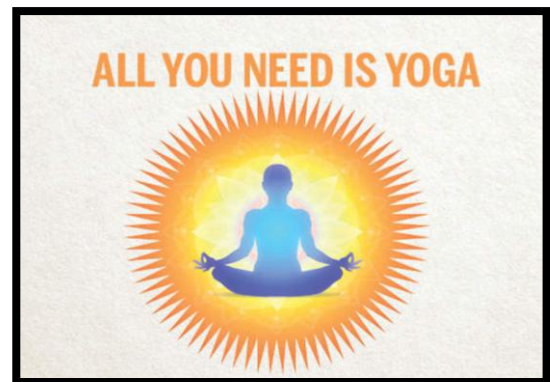

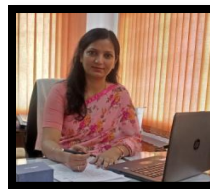
