On 26<sup>th</sup> of January India's 72nd Republic Day was celebrated with great zeal in Jindal Vidya Mandir Kalmeshwar.

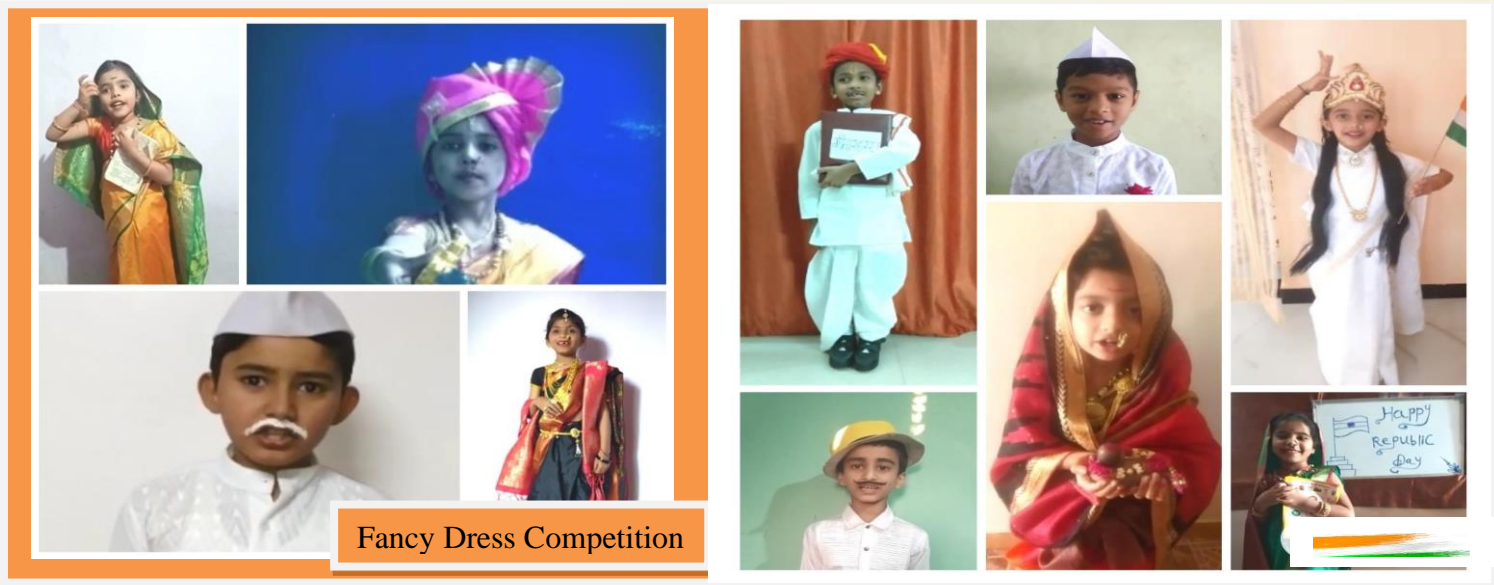

### जिंदल विद्या मंदिर शाळेत मराठी दिवस साजरा

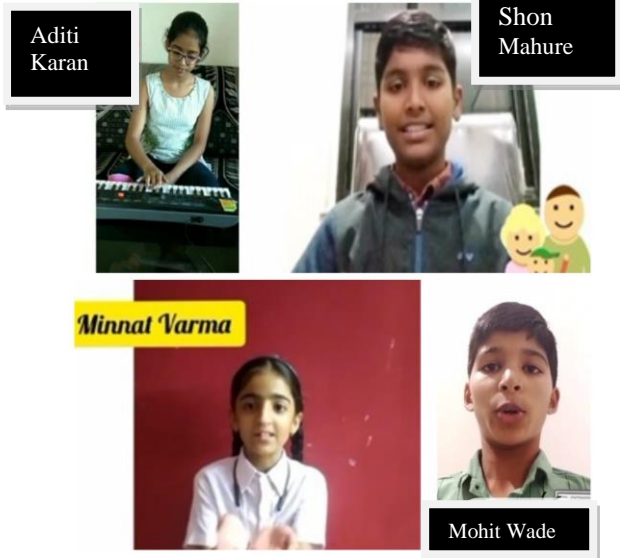

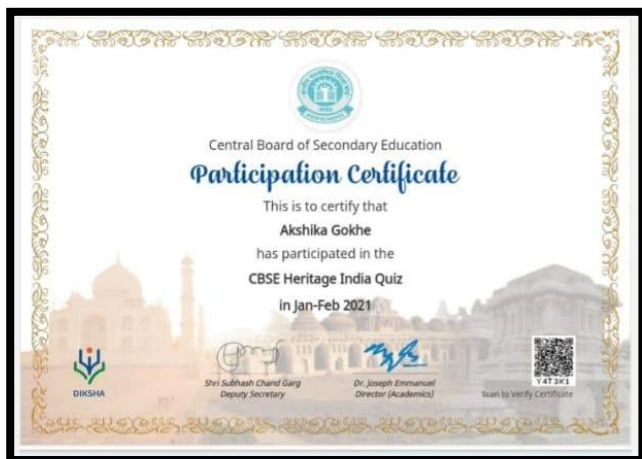
# Heritage Quiz 2020-21

The competition intended to provide exposure of nature to students, increase awareness about treasure of medicines found in nature, establish close relationship of young generation with nature.

The objectives of the competition were to let the students able to research & compile the medicinal values of flora of their surroundings, Popularizing knowledge of medicinal plants and their uses in life.

The participants were required to prepare a PPT on the said topic.
