




Board Protocol

Before presenting in front of class, teachers are sharing their plans with RLC coordinators and doing dry runs if it is required. Timetabling of the given process is helping teachers to practice and imbibe the habit. Reflection and feedback further clarifies the doubts and queries and strengthen the understanding and confidence. The purpose of Board Protocol not just the lesson plan but also serves as a visual cue that reminds us to intentionally notice the learner. By responding to the various sections on the board, students become active participants in the lesson and not just passive listeners.








