From Principal's Desk:


Well Begin is half done!














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My School in Action


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Birth Anniversary of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose:






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


Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav Quiz on Gallantry Award Winner



IAYP Participants in Full Swing towards the Accomplishment of their Skills





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
Museum of Solutions inspiring, enabling and empowering:

The Museum of Solutions empowers children to build a better world together through hands-on experiences based on the real world. Jindal Vidya Mandir, Kalmeshwar organised a clothing conundrum session under Museum of Solutions wherein students were encouraged to come up with their creative ideas for reusing the clothes. Their presentation showcased their spirit, which was a visual treat. Clothing conundrum consisted of three levels which included a variety of teaching and learning methods such as activity and inquiry based learning, collaboration, value focused thinking, reflection and critical thinking.

- * In level one the students were given information on how to explore the variety of unexpected ways fabrics are made.
- * In level two they were encouraged to design a new label for their chosen piece of cloth.
- * In level three they transformed an old damage piece of clothing into bags, clutches, cushion cover, & many more.

The second mission of Museum of Solutions was 'Plastic Predicament' wherein the students were encouraged to dive deep into all things, which surrounds them and understand everything about how plastic is made and ways to solve the problems it creates. Under this mission two levels were conducted.

- * In first level they were motivated to investigate how much plastic they use in their daily life.
- * In level two they learnt the secret code language of plastic recycling, for which they did a scavenger hunt.






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


School Social Responsibility

Wellbeing Session on Stress and Storms of Adolescence Age:

Adolescence is characterized by physical maturation of the brain and body giving rise to psychological and physical change. So to make the children understand these changes a wellbeing session was conducted for the students wherein expert resource persons Ms. Neeta A. Jain Rehabilitation psychologist and counsellor, Founder and joint secretary association of rehabilitation psychologists and professional India, executive member of state psychologist association, founder and director of Anubhuti Foundation, addressed the students. The webinar was conducted to address and spread awareness about common stress faced by adolescents and how can they maintain their wellbeing. 




