
#### From Principal's Desk:




# My School in Action




#### **ISO:** A Step towards Excellence and Ouality Education..



#### IAYP - International Award for Young People India:

The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award is a global framework for non-formal education, which challenges young people aged 14-24 years to dream big, celebrate their achievements and make a difference in the world. The students decide their own goals for skill development, physical recreation, and voluntary service to work on. In progression to their work, the students learned the correct position of guitar, technique to hold and maintain posture while playing a Guitar; they also got to learn how to apply a metronome in their playing and its role in musical arrangement. The students learned how to apply melody lines using major scale over chords, practicing and playing in-sync with each other. To raise awareness on the environmental crisis, the students have created artworks depicting water pollution due to excessive plastic usage, to curb further damage to their surroundings; the students have made signage, paper bags. Participants putting a lot of blood, sweat, and energy straining and raising their endurance capabilities by practicing their Basketball and Soft ball skills.




#### **Fun Day Celebration of Tiny Tots:**




