

Let's March on and March Forward...



IVM in the Making of Nutrition Garden:





Hello, I'm Mrs. Arunima Mukherjee.



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Icebreaker - 'Congenial and Team Building':




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Welcome Back Dear Students...!

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












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International Yoga Day:
















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The Entertainer...


13 years from today, the world lost its biggest entertainer. A singer, dancer, songwriter who inspired a whole new generation of people through his art and performance prowess, regarded as one of the most significant cultural figures of the 20th century; This is all about Michael Jackson.

Michael Joseph Jackson was born on August 29, 1958 to Joseph Walter "Joe" Jackson and Katherine Esther Jackson he was the eighth of the 10 siblings in the Jackson family,. Titled as the "King of Pop" and a career spanning close to 6 decades, his career kicked off after their father formed the band Jackson 5. Michael initially joined the group in 1964 as a vocalist and left the band in 1982, the breakthrough for their project came after Quincy Jones discovered the siblings' musical talent and offered to produce and release their album, lead by Michael on vocals and the siblings playing congas, guitar, bass and percussion, the band recorded and instantly became a hit amongst the audience and musicians alike. The band recorded 10 albums from 1968 to 1975.

Since 1972 Michael ventured out on his solo career as a singer, songwriter and dancer releasing 10 full-length albums from Off the Wall to Invincible over a course of 40 years of his lifetime and 2 albums released posthumously, recognoised as Best-Selling Music Artist of all time, Biggest Entertainer of all Time, Most Awarded Individual Music Artist of All time and the Guinness Book of Records holder of most copies of album sold worldwide for Thriller, Bad, Dangerous, known for Moonwalk, the artist was an inspiration to dancers worldwide, the music, the visuals of his music videos are still enjoyed by fans worldwide, in 1995, Michael and Janet Jackson released music video for Scream which was the most expensive music video of the time. Michael passed away on June 25, 2009, his death was mourned by fans all over the world, a number of individuals and groups paid tribute by performing to one of his songs from the streets of Greece to Hungary and prisoners from Philippines and Grammy Awards to IIFA and putting it all over the internet. His legacy continues to be one of the unmatched and most respected, to quote one of lines from an interview, "I want to be remembered as a Person, not as a Personality". To the person and the personality, I present my gratitude for his music which I myself grew up listening to.
