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
# My School in Action

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


#### **Investiture Ceremony:**




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
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#### World Photography Day: A picture says a thousand words...

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


#### **Independence Day Celebration: The Nation Rejoices...**

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












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



The school believes firmly that this will help the younger generation to become a part of creating a green, clean and sustainable world in the days to come.














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#### **Fancy Dress Competition:**

"The most beautiful world is always entered through imagination."- Helen Keller



The event was coordinated by the classteachers under the ECCE incharge Ms Deepa Nigam.





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


#### Orientation on Career Guidance: The Roadmap of Days to come...















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# Exhibition in community schools under School's Social Responsibility: An initiative to reach out and lend a hand..














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# पुस्तकासारखा दुसरा मित्र नाही....

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
#### Librarian: Curator of the text...
