


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# JSW Paints Presents: FUTURESCAPES National Painting Competition: An Artistic Offering...


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#### The evershining achievement of Mst. Manthan Kamdi

It is well said that "Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world. - Nelson Mandela.



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


#### माझा प्रवास...!

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#### Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav "PROUD TO BE AN INDIAN": The National Pride...



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#### Blue day to commemorate Monsoon: Along comes the rain, Let's Rejoice...



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#### **Kargil Victory Day Celebration:**



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
#### Parent Teacher Association: The Induction and Welcome...














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
