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

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
## Investiture Ceremony

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
## Transport Committee Installation

**Role-play** helps in the development of the basic conversational, linguistic and creative skills for children. Children also learn social skills by collaborating with others in the team while role playing. To experience the same, the students of Grade VII A and B participated in the Role play and showed the dramatization of their textual English Chapter: 1 The Three Questions.

They were divided into two teams consisting of 31 students from each section A and B respectively. Students took on assigned roles or characters and enacted those roles through a scripted play. Each one of the groups used props to make their act presentable thereby showcasing their creativity as well. The role play activity, an experiential learning method, well highlighted the fact that Students' gain additional meaning from the context of role playing rather than from context specific book learning and lectures.



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


# Experiments don't fail, they just give different results.


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#### "Newspapers are tutors as well as informers."


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### Monsoon Day Celebration

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

#### **NSSC Workshop on NEP**

## Mutual understanding of challenges with new immerging system after implementation of NEP.

Nagpur Sahodaya School Complex organised Subject based Social Science workshop to enhance the ability of social teachers with curriculum and NEP. The outset, Team building activity was organised for setting the tone of the day. The Resource person discussed and explained provisions in NEP and CBSE curriculum. In the second half Jayati Chakroborty, elaborated about question formation and identification of typology of questions enhancing case study and competency based question, analysing of the recent sample QP of CBSE was done. During the last phase of workshop teachers were divided in groups subject wise to prepare 8 questions based on different typology and these question bank was to be submitted to NSSC for sharing with larger group. Overall the workshop was useful for teacher to understand the new changes introduced by CBSE.





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## School Quality, Assessment and Assurance Framework workshop

To enable the schools to implement the SQAA framework in an effective manner and undertake self-assessment objectively, CBSE Hubs of learning organised a series of experiential SQAA workshop wherein all the aspects of the framework were discussed from 24th July to 27th July 2023. In total of 4 days' work shop the resource person briefed all the 7 domains, and how to work as a core team and how to upload the documents and what type of supporting documents are required for school self-assessment. The participants collaborated to prepare the policy for each domain and presented in front of the large group which made the participants active and engaged. It was very enriching and fruitful session. Team of 4 teachers Mr. Parag B., Ms. Sumita Faithfulwar, Ms. Priyanka Wasnik and Ms. Deepa Nigam represented JVM school and extended gratitude towards the Principal, Ms. Pallavi Chakkilala for providing the given opportunity for professional development.


