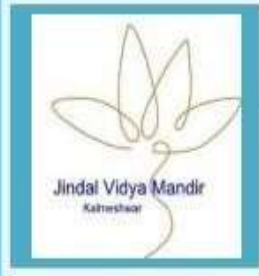

Namaskar!

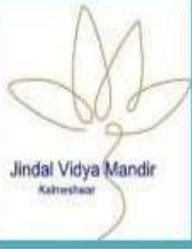

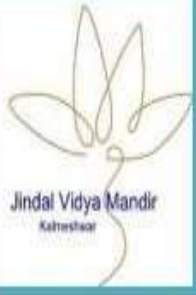


## **My School in Action**

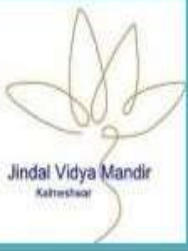


## **Rakhi Celebration**

### Under 14 Girls Results:

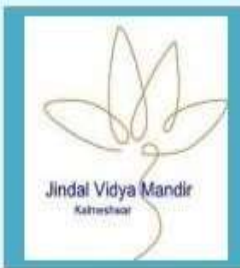

You're valuable, cherished, break the gloom.

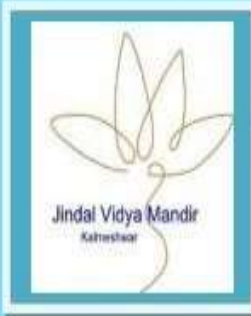

## **GRIT AND GLORY :**

### **Unveiling The Hidden Power Of Relentless Hardwork ...**

Reena : Hrithik, what do you think will be a proper definition of hard work ?

Hrithik : Well , as the name suggests hard and work. It means working hard.

Reena : Do you think splitting a word into its constituents is a correct way to approach for its meaning ?

Hrithik : I don't know about that , what's your perspective ?

Reena : I say, not completely . Let's see two examples, A woodcutter is doing his work without sharpening his tools for hours . It is hardwork for him. On the other hand, another woodcutter uses sharp tools and completes his work of two days in a stretch. What do you think is the real hard work?

Hrithik: Offcourse the second one!

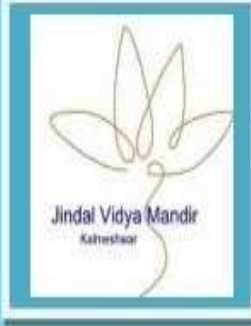
Reena : But you said that hardwork is working hard ? So don't you think the first woodcutter has also done hard work ?

From this dialogic exchange it's clear that people accept a wrong way to approach towards the meaning of a word, whereas the internal discourse of that particular word is totally different. Hard work is one such word which is timely interpreted wrong. I say hard work is not only working hard but to be diligent with a sense of compassion towards the work which we take in our hands. Without passion, hard work can often feel tedious and uninspiring. Recently, I came across an incident wherein my relatives decided to visit their farmhouse and for the same they started the preparations. 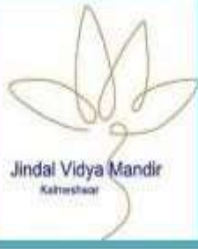

The day is celebrated on the occasion of Birth Anniversary of Padmashree Dr Shiyali Ramamrita Ranganathan who is known as the father of Library Science. S. R. Ranganathan. He was born in Shiyali , Thanjavur District of TamilNadu on 12th August 1892. Ranganathan began his professional life as a mathematician; he earned B.A. and M.A. degrees in mathematics from Madras Christian College.

In the year 1924-1925, he visited England to study and observe the library work at University College, London.

His most notable contributions to the field were his five laws of library Science in year 1931

The five laws of library science are as follows:

- 1) Books are for use.
- 2) Every reader his / her book.
- 3) Every book its reader.
- 4) Save the time of the reader.
- 5) The library is a growing organism.

He also developed the Colon Classification system of library organization in 1933. In the year 1957 the Government of India awarded him Padma Shri for his valuable contributions towards Library Science.

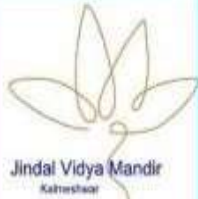
जीवनात खेळाचे महत्व.....

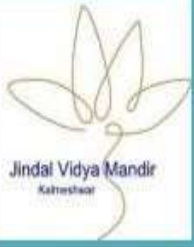

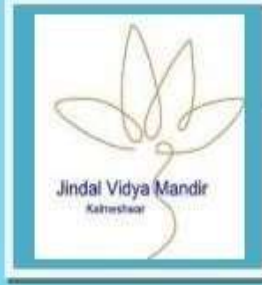

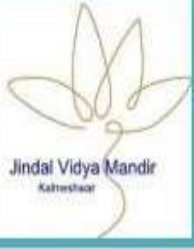
