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
Student's Section






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

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गणतंत्र दिवस पर रंगारंग कार्यक्रम




Saraswati Pujan at JVM































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





























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Shivaji Jayanti Celebration

The special assembly conduction aimed to throw light on the life and achievements of the great Maratha leader Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.







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


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जिंदल विद्या मंदिर शाळेत मराठी दिवस उत्साहात साजरा.....





















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

The Model making competition commemorating National Science Day was held for three different categories (Category A -Grade III and IV, Category B- Grade V and VI, Category C- VII and VIII). 





























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Class IX students engaged in playing scrabble, the game which encourages to explore, expand and improve vocabulary building and learning skills using the letter tiles.












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
