The annual health checkup camp was another milestone accomplished seeking community partnership to support good health and timely screening of the children with special needs.

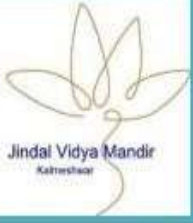

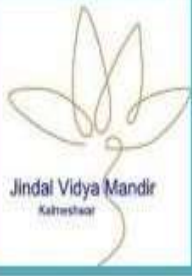

"A Leader is one who knows the way, goes the way and shows the ways."

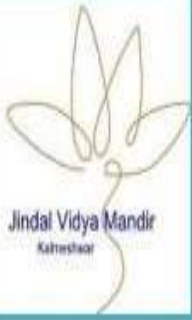

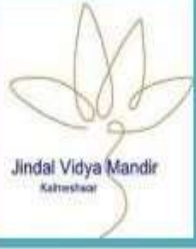
## **Stress buster: Meditation program for class X**

The programme concluded with a vote of thanks given by Mr. Govind Pal.



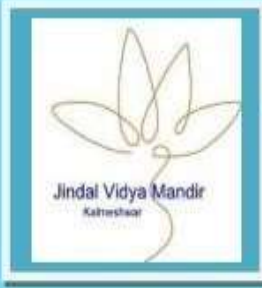

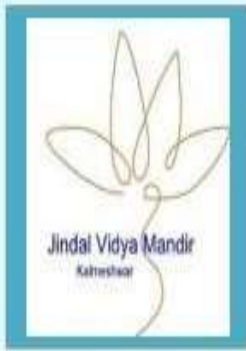


## **Kargil Vijay Diwas**

## **Green Campus Conclave**

The Green Campus Conclave (GCC), an event to educate teachers and students on how to enhance sustainable practices at campus, concluded on Friday 5 July 2024 at the National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (Neeri) auditorium. Organized by The Climate Project Foundation (TCPF). The event focused on promoting tree plantation, utilizing wastewater, and fostering a sustainable campus environment.

Powered by The Times of India and organized by the Global Shapers Nagpur (GSN) in collaboration with 'Jigyasa', the event witnessed participation of an enthusiastic crowd who showed interest in the green campus programme. The program began with the introduction of the concept of green campus and its benefits for a balanced ecosystem, by a GSN representative during his inaugural speech. Atul Vaidya, Director, NEERI, said, "Simply planting trees does not make a campus green. Planting is the final step. What we receive and what we contribute is crucial." Prakash Kumbhare, Principal and Scientist at Neeri, introduced 'Project Jigyasa,' emphasizing on the scientific social responsibility of students. "When this project was launched in 2017, the Prime Minister envisioned a society with a scientific approach, especially among students. Today, teachers primarily follow the syllabus, but learning should extend beyond it," Kumbhare said. Rekha Lalla, Lead-Green Campus Programme, also shared her views during the event. "All the wildlife and water bodies are contributing to the purity of air in Nagpur. As compared to Delhi, my lungs feel much happier here," she added.

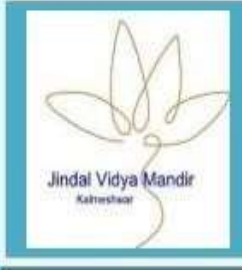

**At every step, at any stage I find you standing by my side.**

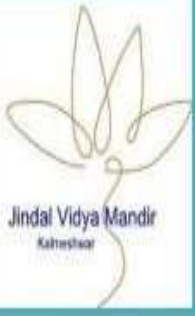

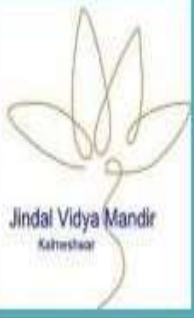

## **Gestures Come in Clusters**

The human body is a symphony of movements; each gesture a note that contributes to the grand opus of communication. As illustrated by the vivid lines from W.S. Gilbert's comic opera *Patience*, physical gestures often come in clusters, weaving together a rich tapestry of expression that conveys our innermost emotions and intentions. "His nose should pant and his lip should curl. His cheek should flame and his brow should furl. His bosom should heave and his heart should glow, and his fist be ever ready for a knock-down blow." These lines encapsulate the essence of how multiple gestures combine to paint a picture more vibrant and telling than words alone ever could. Consider the simple act of anger. When one is furious, it is not just the clenching of fists that conveys this emotion. The entire body becomes an instrument of expression. The brow furrows, the lips curl, the cheeks flush with a sudden rush of blood, and the breath becomes rapid and shallow. Each of these gestures, in isolation, might not communicate the depth of the emotion. However, when they occur in tandem, they leave no doubt about the intensity of the feeling. Similarly, love and affection are not merely shown through a smile. The eyes soften, the body leans in, the voice lowers, and a gentle touch on the arm may follow. This clustering of gestures creates a powerful message of intimacy and care, one that resonates more deeply than a simple verbal declaration. The science behind these clusters of gestures is rooted in our evolutionary biology. Humans are social creatures, and our survival has long depended on our ability to communicate effectively with one another. Over millennia, we have developed a nuanced system of non-verbal cues that enhance our spoken language. These gestures are processed by the brain in ways that are often more immediate and visceral than words. They tap into our primal instincts, allowing us to convey and interpret emotions quickly and accurately. In the realm of performance, whether on stage or screen, the clustering of gestures becomes an essential tool for actors. It is through the careful orchestration of facial expressions, body movements, and vocal intonations that a character's inner world is brought to life. A skilled actor knows that a single raised eyebrow can suggest skepticism, but when paired with a sidelong glance and a slight shift in posture, it can convey a world of unspoken doubt and intrigue. In everyday life, we are all actors in our own right, constantly using gestures to complement and enhance our words. Think of a politician giving a speech: the cadence of their delivery, the emphatic hand gestures, the deliberate pauses—all these elements work together to persuade and inspire their audience. Or consider a parent comforting a child: the soothing tone of voice, the gentle rocking motion, the reassuring hug—all these gestures cluster to create a sense of safety and love. Understanding the power of gesture clusters can also improve our personal and professional relationships. Being mindful of how we use our body language can help us become more effective communicators. For instance, maintaining eye contact, nodding in agreement, and mirroring the other person's posture can foster a sense of connection and trust. Conversely, recognizing when someone's gestures are out of sync with their words can alert us to underlying tensions or dishonesty.

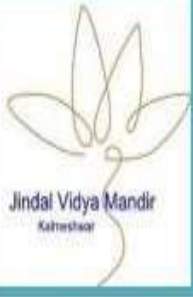
