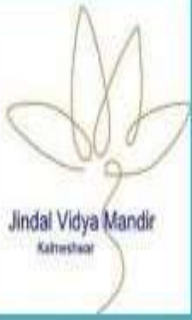
My School in Action

Do I sound of Exaggeration? Then read these sage words ...

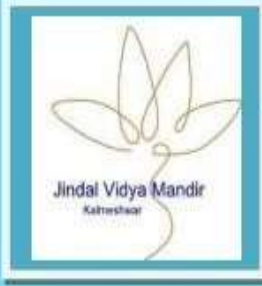

Professional development workshop for teachers



Two days professional development training program was conducted for the teaching staff in the school activity room. Ms Surabhi Arora Mahajan, an Eduartist was the resource person. On the first day of the training session, she conducted various hands on activities experiential learning, art integration activity, timeline activity through inquiry based learning and constructivist approach, introduced aeroplane designing and modifying activity, Budget planning activity etc. On the second day of the session, Ms Surabhi briefly explained the need of constructivist lesson plans which include setting scene, eliciting existing idea and restructuring. She highlighted the skill of questioning and competency based learning. The Art of questioning, Preparation of Rubrics and development of question paper. She shared reference materials like lesson plans, sample question papers which were designed considering Blooms taxonomy etc. She further asked to create pedagogies around students and promote project based learning. She further added, Assessment must match teaching methodologies. At the end of the session Ms Deepa thanked the resource person through a token of thankfulness and remembrance. The session came to an end with the thanking speech by the Principal, she thanked the resource person and management for organising continuous professional development and capacity building programs. She highlighted the importance of teachers as a facilitator and hoped for a good change and fruitful results in the classroom.

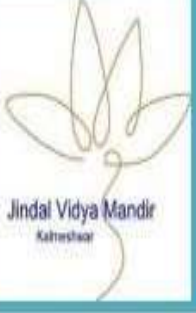
1. Ants don't have lungs. They instead breathe through spiracles, nine or ten tiny openings, depending on the species.

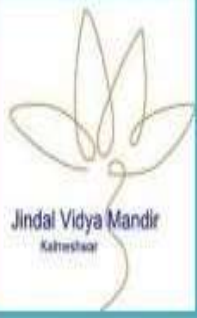

ज्ञान का उजाला

महाराष्ट्र में एक जिला पड़ता है सोलापुर । कभी यह शहर अपनी सूती चादरों के लिए जाना जाता था । इसी जिले में एक गाँव है इस्लामपुर । महाराष्ट्र में शिक्षा के प्रति अन्य सूबों की तुलना में यहाँ कुछ ज्यादा ही समर्पण और आकर्षण भाव देखा जाता रहा है । अहिल्या बाई का ही किस्सा ले लीजिए । जब वे इंदौर (मालवा अंचल) की महारानी बनकर आई थीं तो अहमदनगर (अब अहिल्या नगर) के पास स्थित अपने गाँव में दूसरे बच्चों को जो एक शिक्षक पढ़ाने आता था , तो वे उनकी बातें छुपकर सुनतीं और शिक्षित होतीं । आगे चलकर लोकमाता अहिल्या बाई ने पूरे समाज के लिए शिक्षा के दरवाजे खोल दिए ।

उक्त इस्लामपुर गाँव में कभी एक प्राइमरी स्कूल हुआ करती थी । बच्चों की क्लास चल रही होती थी । एक बच्चा खिड़की के पास खड़ा होकर चुपचाप शिक्षक की बातें सुनता रहता । आने - जाने वाले लोग उसको देखते और अपने रास्ते निकल जाते । एक दिन वहाँ से कोई मुसाफिर गुजर रहा था । वो रुका , बच्चे से बात की । बच्चे ने बताया कि वो पढ़ना चाहता है लेकिन उसे कक्षा में इसलिए प्रवेश नहीं दिया जा रहा है कि वह अछूत जाति से आता है । इस मुसाफिर ने शिक्षक को समझाने की लाख कोशिश की , मगर नतीजा सिफ़र । बच्चे को उस मुसाफिर ने अपने साथ लिया और फिर उसे पास ही स्थित कोल्हापुर शहर ले गया । उन दिनों शाहूजी महाराज छुआछूत के खिलाफ़ एक सुनियोजित अभियान चला रहे थे । उन्हीं के प्रयासों की बदौलत कोल्हापुर में 'मिस क्लार्क' नाम से छात्रावास चल रहा था , वही उस बच्चे का दाखिला करवा दिया गया ।

जब यह बच्चा पढ़ - लिखकर १९२० में मुंबई आया । तो उसे डॉ॰ भीमराव आंबेडकर द्वारा शुरू किए गए ' मूक नायक ' समाचार पत्र में बतौर प्रबंधक और संपादक नियुक्ति मिल गई । आगे चलकर उन्हें महाराष्ट्र विधान परिषद में सदस्य भी बनाया गया । उक्त बच्चे का नाम था ज्ञानदेव ध्रुवनाथ घोलप । यह जान लेना और जरूरी है कि घोलप को जिन सज्जन ने ज्ञान तथा शिक्षा के रास्ते का उजाला दिखाया था , उनका नाम था कर्मवीर भाऊराव पाटिल , जिन्होंने सातारा शहर में रेयात शिक्षण संस्थान की स्थापना भी की थी । कर्मवीर भाऊराव पाटिल को साल १९५९ में पद्मभूषण सम्मान से नवाजा गया ।

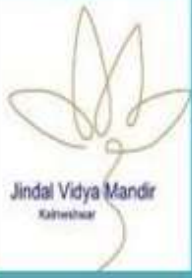
