मौन का जादू

भारतवर्ष के महान ऋषियों ने वाणी के संयम को 'वाक् ब्रह्मचर्य' कहा है और इसलिए ही जो व्यक्ति मौन का आदी है, जब वह बोलता है तो उसके बोल सारयुक्त, गहरे, गंभीर और मीठे होते हैं। हमने अक्सर यह सुना है कि 'जो गरजते हैं वह बरसते नहीं' अर्थात् जिनकी शक्तियाँ व्यर्थ बोलने में अधिक खर्च हो जाती है, कार्य करते समय उन्हें उन शक्तियों की कमी पड़ जाती है। इसलिए ही संसार के जितने भी रचनात्मक कार्य करने वाले महापुरुष, वैज्ञानिक, ग्रंथकार एवं महात्मा हुए हैं वे सभी प्रायः मितभाषी थे।

एक बार एक शिष्य ने अपने आचार्य से प्रश्न किया कि 'भगवन, ब्रह्म को कैसे प्राप्त किया जा सकता है? आचार्य ने कोई उत्तर न दिया। शिष्य ने सात बार यह प्रश्न पूछा पर आचार्य सातों बार चुप रहे। अंत में उन्होंने कहा - हे वत्स! मैं बार-बार उत्तर दे रहा हूँ, पर तू समझता ही नहीं। उस ब्रह्म को वाणी से कहा - सुना नहीं जा सकता। उसे तो मौन होकर ही समझा और प्राप्त किया जा सकता है। वास्तव में मौन केवल शब्दों का अभाव नहीं बल्कि चेतना की सजग अवस्था है। जब मन शांत होता है, तब भीतर के सूक्ष्म बुद्धि जागृत होती है और निर्णय अधिक स्पष्ट व संतुलित बनते हैं। आज के कोलाहलपूर्ण वातावरण में, जहाँ प्रत्येक व्यक्ति अपनी बात कहने की होड़ में है, मौन हमें स्वयं से जुड़ने का अवसर देता है। मौन हमें प्रतिक्रिया नहीं प्रत्युत्तर देना सिखाता है। आवेश नहीं, विवेक चुनना सिखाता है। अनेक बार कटु वचन संबंधों में जो दरार डाल देते हैं, वही दरारें समय पर धारण किया गया मौन भर देता है। इसलिए मौन को कमजोरी नहीं आत्मबल का प्रतीक समझना चाहिए।

It teaches resilience.




