CURRICULUM INNOVATION-NEP 2020

From 13-15th February 2023 brain storming sessions on NEP2020 was conducted for the teachers .The purpose of this workshop was to provide an in-depth understanding of the National Education Policy 2020 and discuss ways to implement its objectives effectively.

Workshop Details:

The workshop was facilitated by the school teachers on education policy who provided a detailed overview of NEP2020. COE ACTIVITY -SURKSHA

Our school on 27th Feb.2023 organised a Community Outreach Program with the help of the Sanjeevani hospital's member Mr. Sushil . CPR (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) is an emergency life-saving technique used to revive a person who has suffered cardiac arrest or respiratory failure. The program was focused on CPR training which had a significant impact on public health by equipping people with life-saving skills.The program aim was to create awareness about the importance of CPR, teach the proper techniques for performing CPR, and educate people on how to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) if available. The training should also emphasize the need for quick response and encourage participants to call emergency services as soon as possible.



FIRE SAFETY-INSPECTION



Fire accidents can lead to loss of precious life and property. Fire is unpredictable and can happen anywhere and at any time. So, a team from fire department visited our school last week for fire safety inspection. This inspection covered all aspects of fire safety, including the fire alarm system, emergency lighting, exit routes, fire extinguishers, electrical hazards, and kitchen hazards. The inspector found that the school's fire safety measures were in good condition. School has received NOC (Fire Safety Certificate) applicable till February 22, 2025.

ORIGAMI WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS



On 10th Feb 2023 an origami workshop was conducted for teachers. The purpose of this workshop was to teach teachers how to incorporate origami into their lessons and create a fun, engaging learning experience for students. MUSIC ACTIVITY






