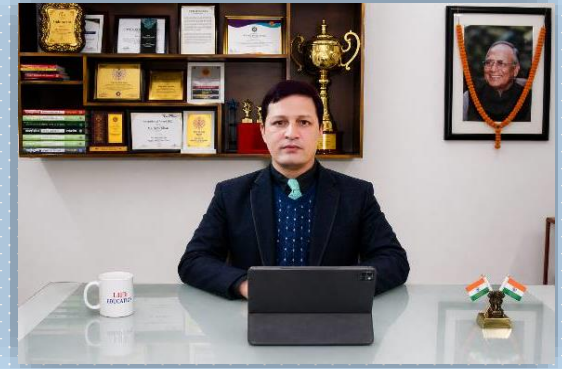

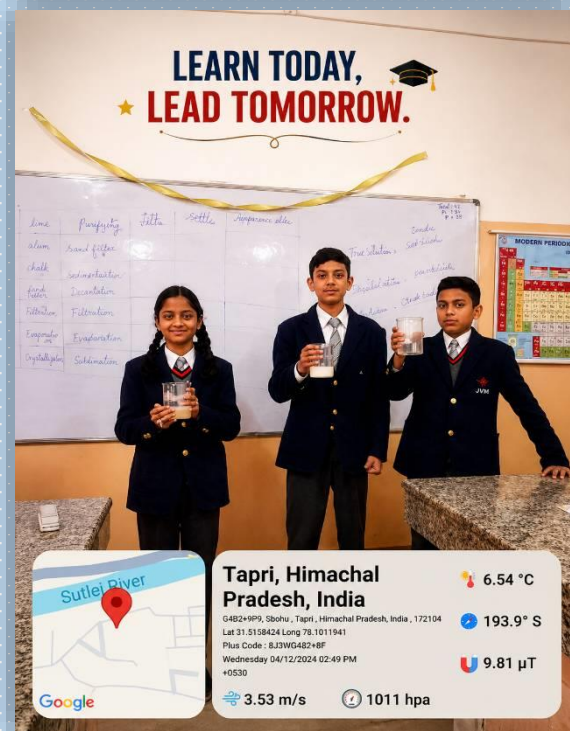
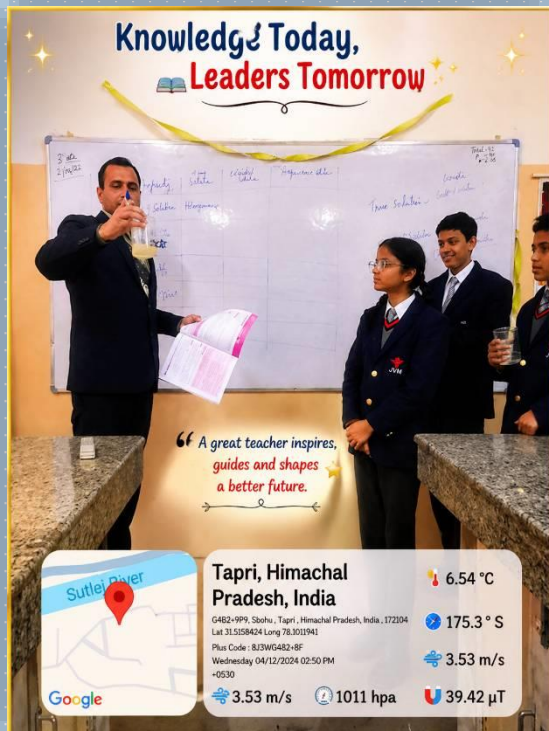

“Exploring Magnets – Class VI Activity”

They observed that magnets attract materials like **iron** but not **plastic or wood**, identified the **two poles**, and learned that **like poles repel while opposite poles attract**.

Students also discovered that a magnet’s strength is **maximum at its poles** and connected this knowledge to real-life uses such as **fridge magnets, compass needles, and everyday tools**. The activity made learning **practical and engaging**.

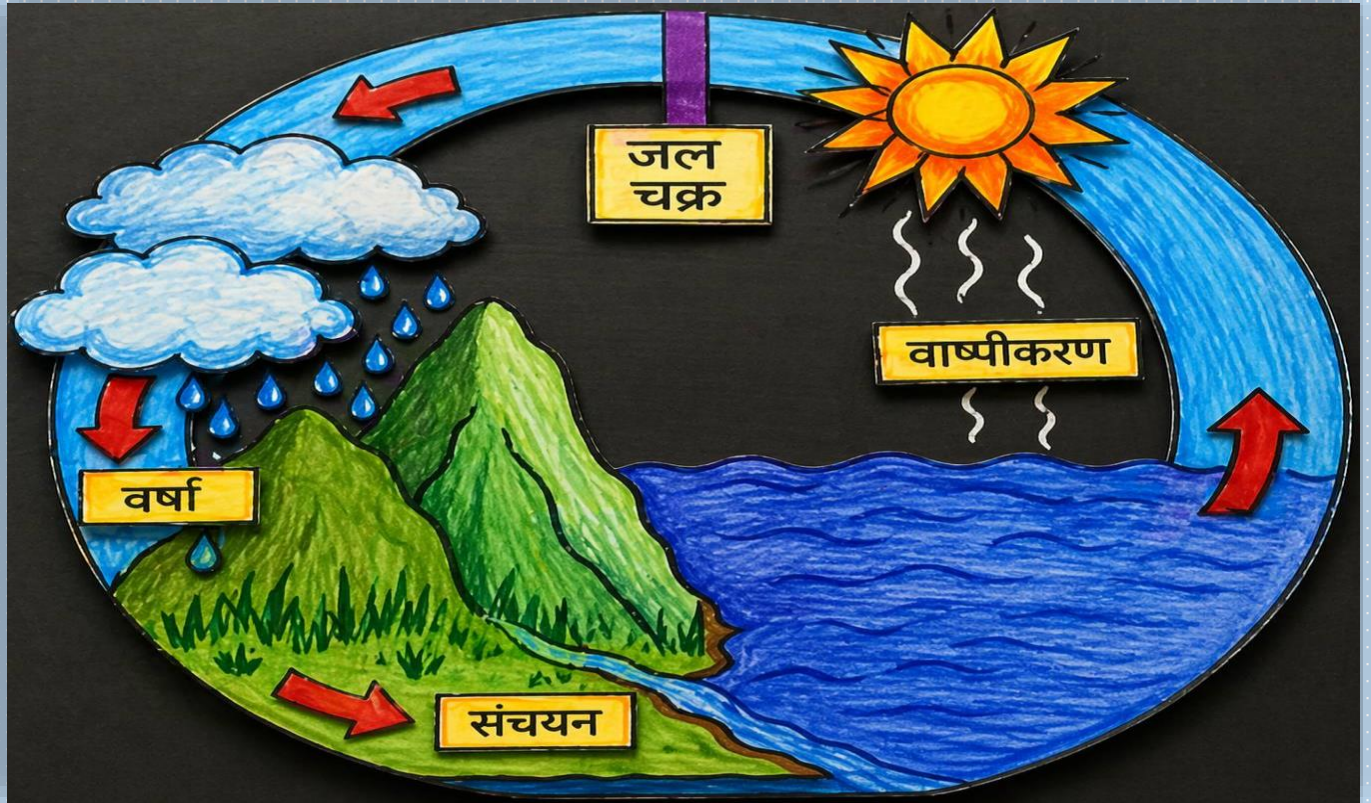

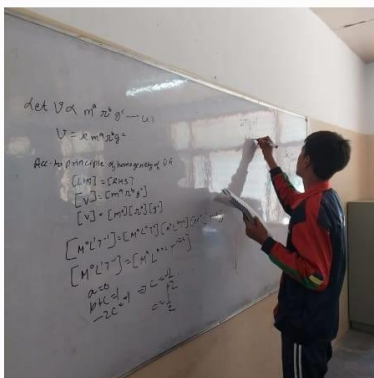


Physics – Group Activity

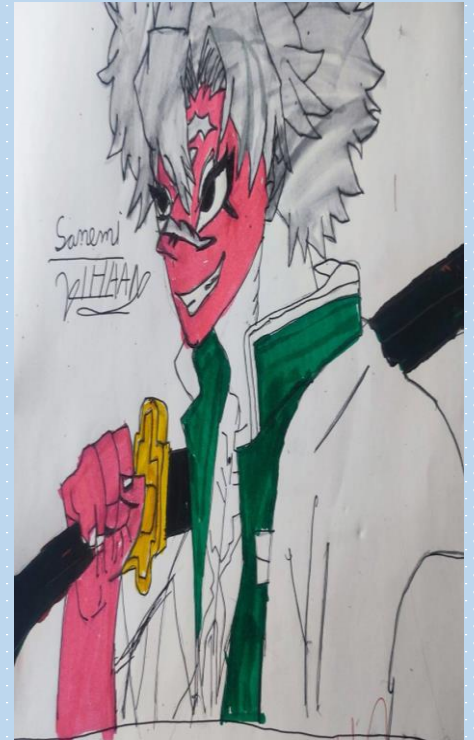
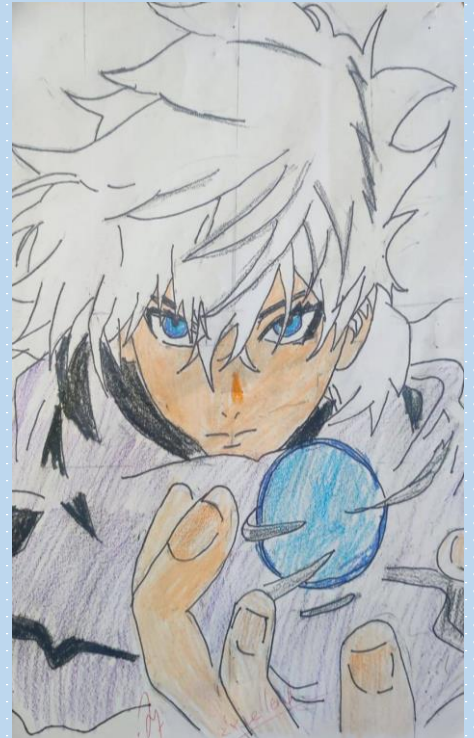
Shivansh Srivastava Shines: From DLEPC to SLEPC Achievement

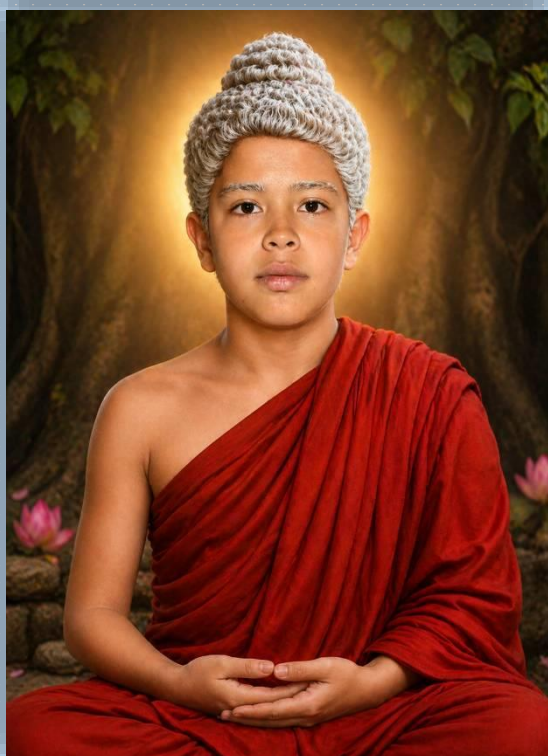
