अंत में सभी बच्चों ने अपनी सुंदर कृतियों का आत्मविश्वास के साथ प्रदर्शन किया। 🌈

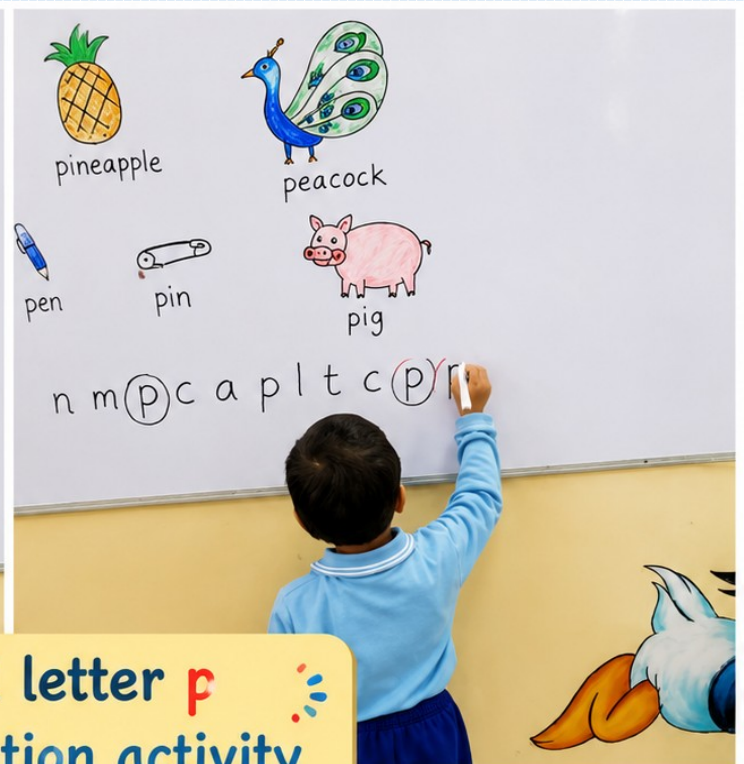
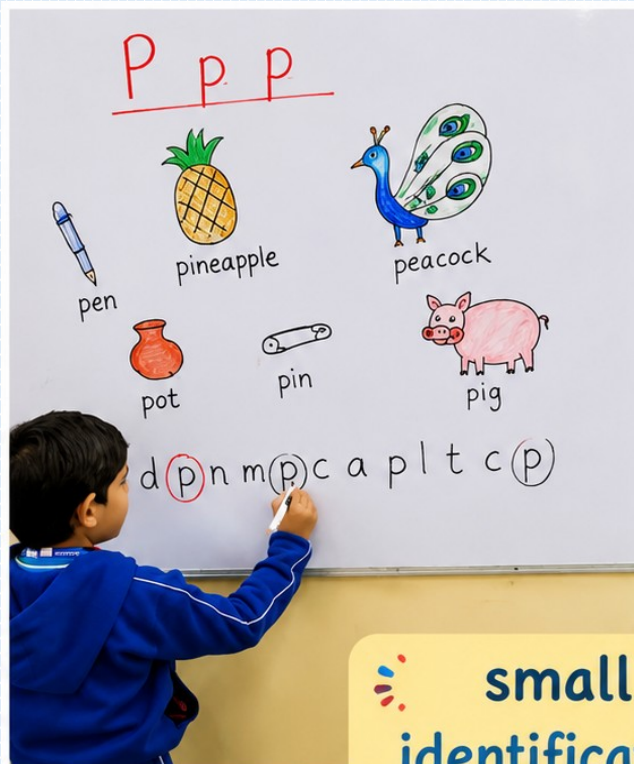


Small Letter 'p' Identification Activity (LKG)

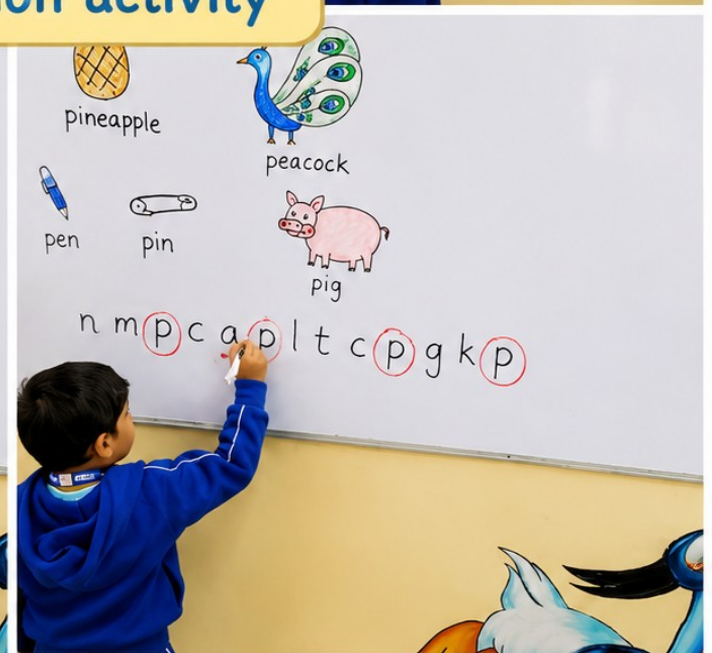

Ganitmala Activity: Identifying Numbers and Counting Beads

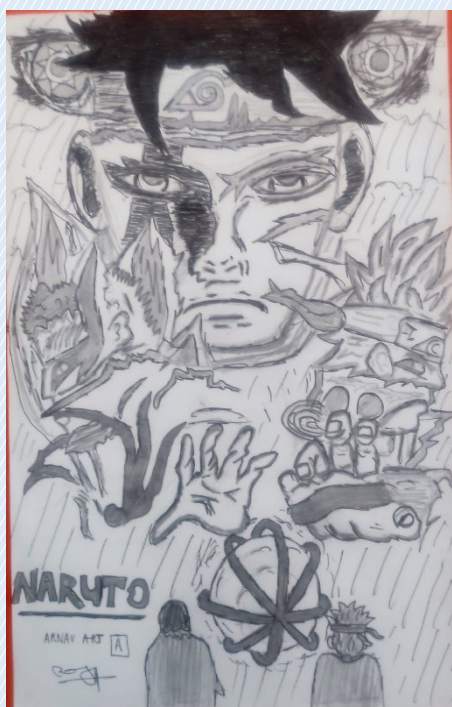

Students' Creativity Corner

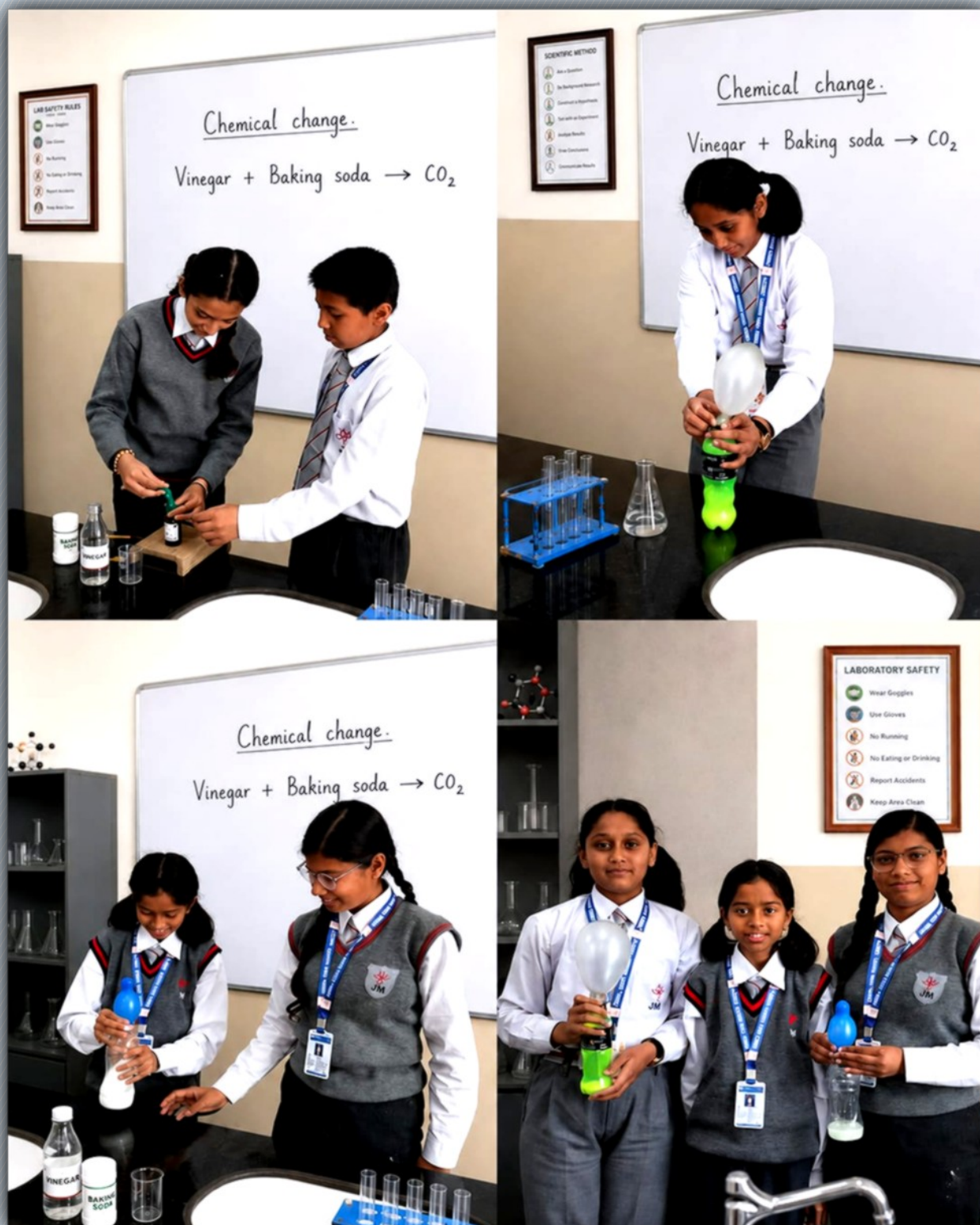

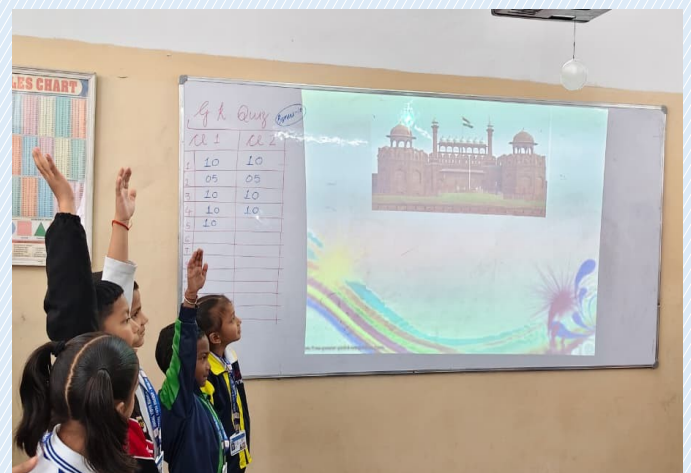

Basketball Dribbling Activity (Classes 1 & 2)

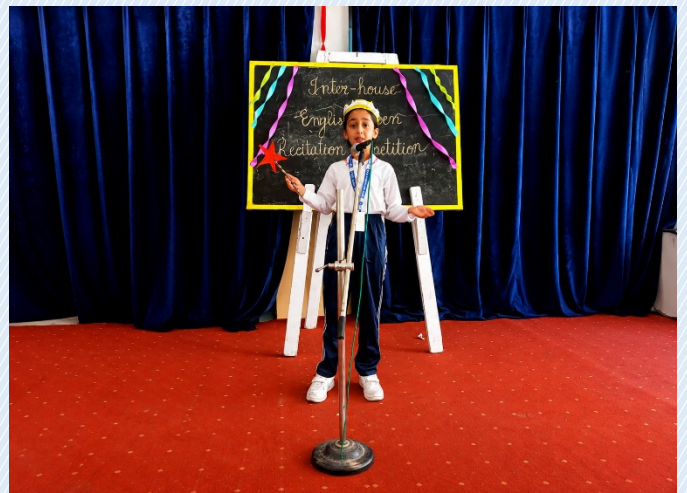

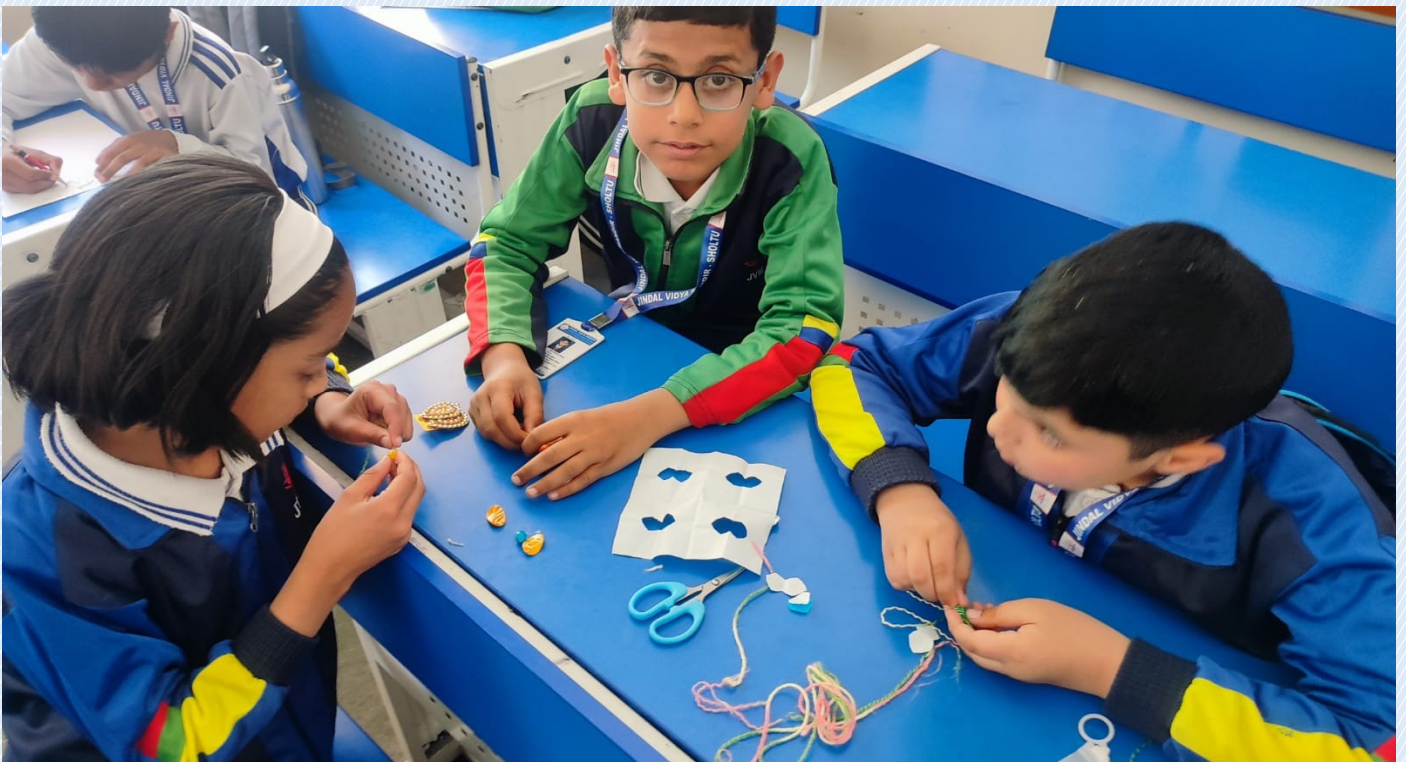
English Poem Recitation Competition (Classes III-V)

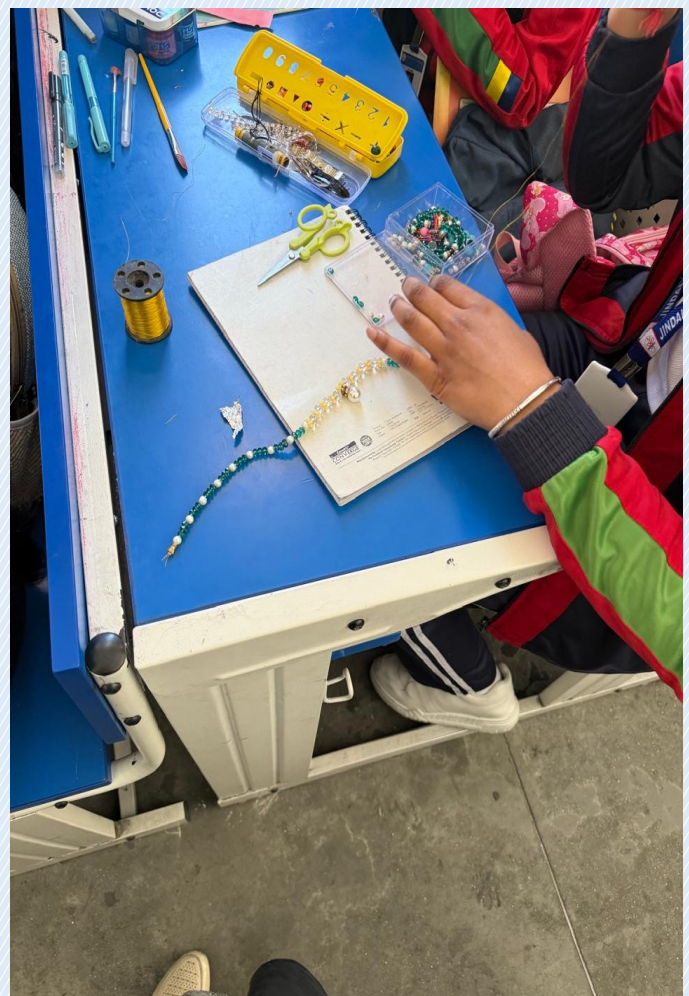
Jewellery Making Activity (Class VI)

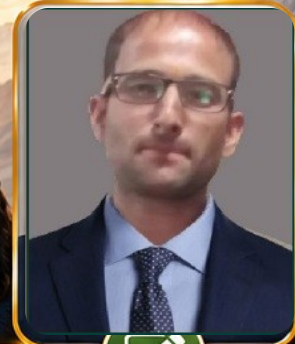
