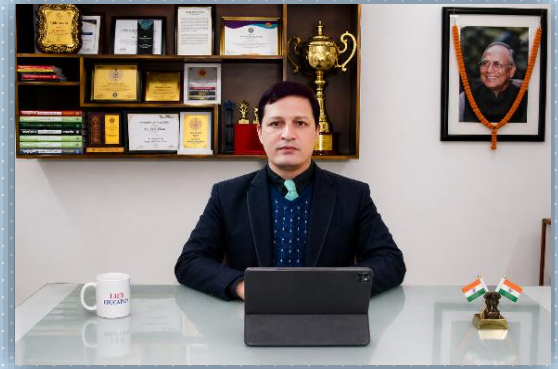

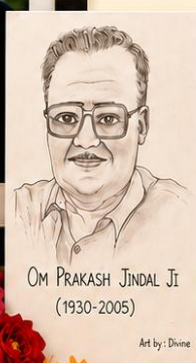
A Heartfelt Tribute to the Visionary – Mr. O.P. Jindal

Om Prakash Tindal

The founder of OP Tindal Group is a major steel and power conglomerate empire.

I am talking about Om Prakash Tindal also known as OP Tindal.

He was born on 7 Aug, 1930.

Shri Om Prakash Tindal was a legendary Indian industrialist, philanthropist and politician. Starting from a humble bucket-making unit, he built a massive steel and power empire and became a pioneering, pure in Indian industrial self-reliance.

Now, I will tell you about his -

Early life and beginnings -

He was born in Hisar village, Hisar dist Haryana to a farmer family (late Shri Nekram Tindal).

He received basic schooling in his village and the nearby town of Hansi. He had limited formal training and was often lightheartedly called a 'sixth - standard pass engineer' due to his practical genius.

He showed an early fascination with machinery, often dismantling and reassembling farm tools. His political and public life earned 3 terms as a member of the Haryana Legislative Assembly.

He was elected as a member of Parliament to the 11th Lok Sabha in 1996.

He founded heavily on social welfare, rural

development and education initiatives.

His Personal life and legacy -

- He married Savitri Tindal, with whom along with his 4 sons, wife Vidya Devi - he raised a large family including prominent sons Prithvi Raj, Sajjan Tindal and Naveen.
- He tragically passed away on 31 March, 2005 in a helicopter crash.
- Left behind a robust business legacy managed by his wife and sons, which expanded into major independent global entities i.e. JSW Groups and Tindal Steel & Power.

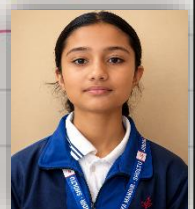
August 7 is widely observed as the birth anniversary of Om Prakash Tindal, Tomorrow is his 96th birth anniversary.

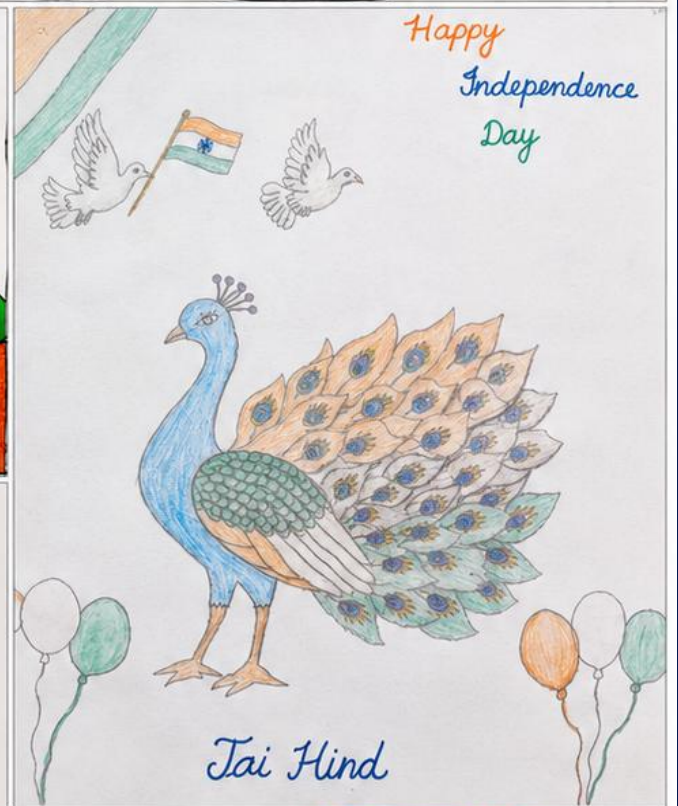

Class 4 | Mathematics Activity | Circumference of a Circle

✏ Learning by Doing!

Our Class 4 students explored **circumference** through a fun hands-on activity using **thread, scale, compass and glue**.

● What They Did

1. Drew a circle of **radius 3 cm**.
2. Wrapped thread around its boundary.
3. Straightened and measured the thread.
4. Pasted the thread around the circle and alongside it for comparison.

✏ What They Discovered

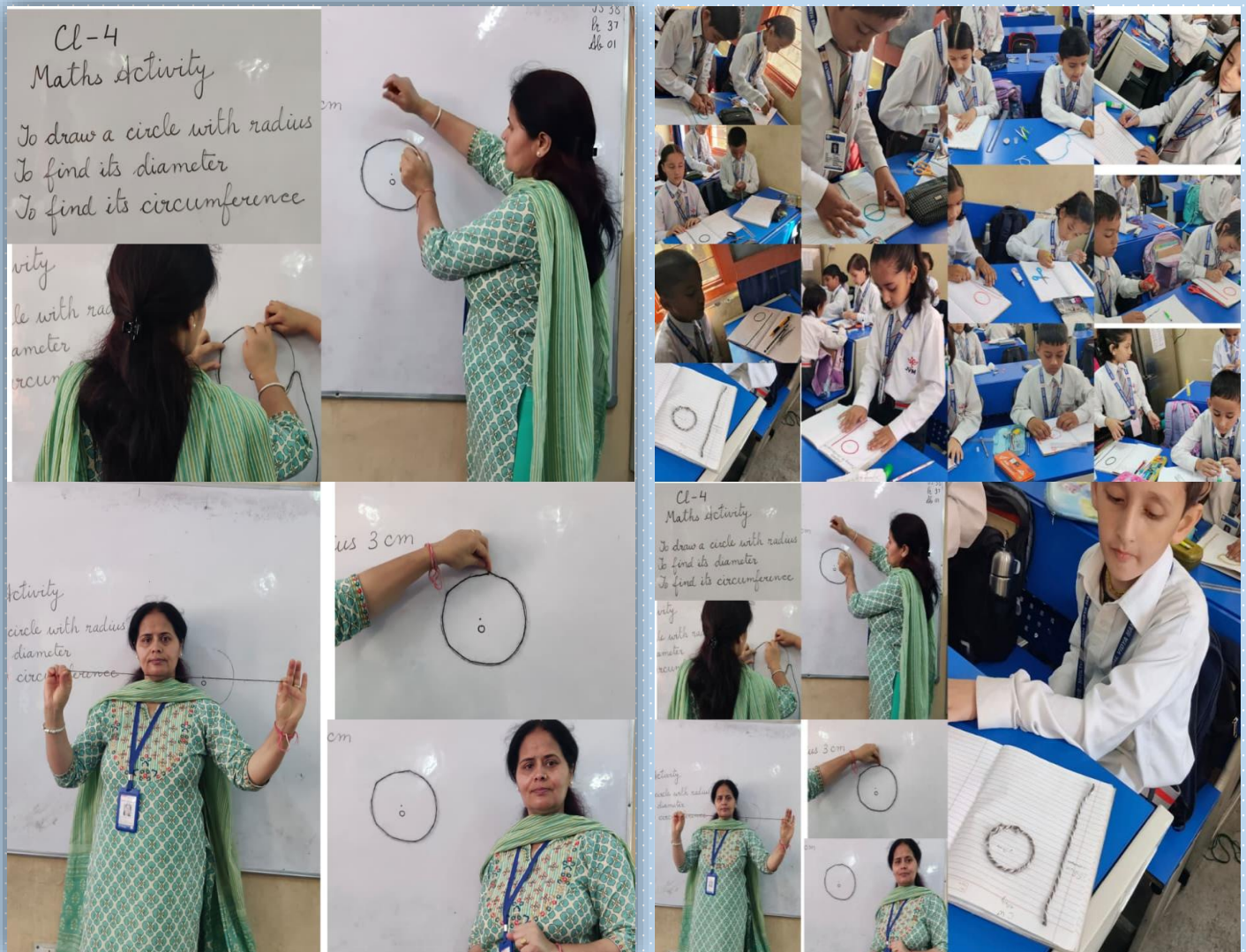
Circumference = Length around the circle = 18.8 cm

✨ They learned that a curved boundary can be measured using a simple thread—and **the bigger the circle, the greater its circumference!**

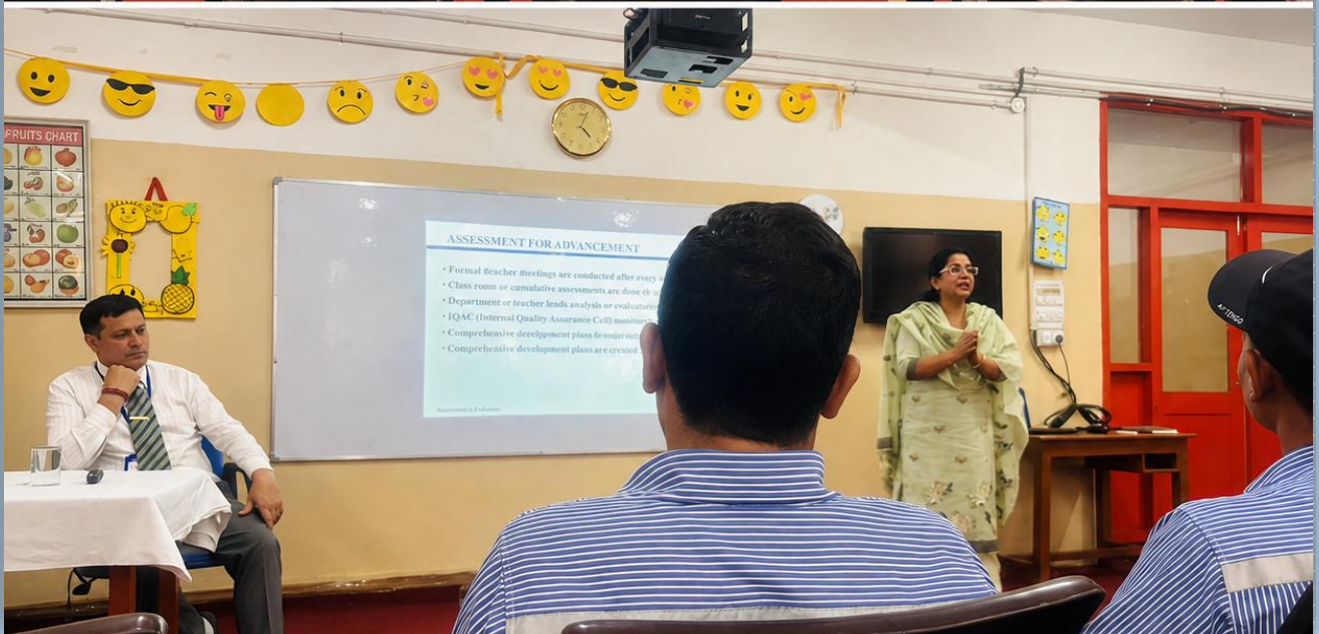
